CIVIL WAR SESQUICENTENNIAL Book Presentation and Signing

To celebrate the sesquicentennial (150th Anniversary) of the Civil War, Riverhead Town Historian, Georgette Lane Case, will present her new book entitled: ***We Will Not Forget: Riverhead's Civil War Soldiers and Sailors.***

"We Will Not Forget" is a 91-page collection of all the military names that could be verified, plus those who were Killed in Action, Wounded and Prisoners of War, with sketches of a few of Riverhead's soldiers and sailors including several photographs. The book contains a full name index.

A book presentation and signing will take place at the American Legion Post 273 located at 89 Hubbard Avenue, Riverhead NY on Saturday, November 12th at 1:30 p.m.

Guests will include the 88th Regiment N.Y.S.V. Civil War re-enactors describing camp life and descendants of Riverhead's soldiers.
