Weather and Travel Advisory

The National Weather Service has extended the following advisories for our area.

Advisory	When	Where	What
Coastal Flood Warning	Starting Sunday (10/12/25) at 8:00AM until Monday (10/13/25) at 8:00PM	Town-wide	One to two feet of inundation above ground level possible in vulnerable areas near the waterfront and shoreline
High Wind Warning	Starting Sunday (10/12/25) at 12:00PM until Monday (10/13/25) at 6:00PM	Town-wide	Northeast winds 25-35mph with gusts up to 60mph possible

Flooding of vulnerable areas near the waterfront and shoreline, including roadways, parking lots, parks. High winds can down trees and powerlines. Always assume downed powerlines are energized and stay away. In case of an emergency, dial 911. Non-emergency calls can reach the Riverhead Police Department at 631-727-4500.

If travel is required, allow extra time as some roads may be closed. Do not drive around barricades or through water of unknown depth. Take the necessary actions to protect flood prone property.
