NO COST* COLORECTAL SCREENING EVENT

Did you know?

- The lifetime risk of developing colorectal cancer is about 1 in 24 for men and 1 in 26 for women.
- The American Cancer Society recommends starting regular screening at age 45.

Colorectal cancer screening will be conducted via FIT (Fecal Immunochemical Test) which is a sensitive test that looks for signs of cancer in a person's stool. No prior registration necessary. No eligibility requirements.

*Uninsured patients are welcome. Insurance information will be collected from those who are covered by insurance. Annual screenings are fully covered by insurance for those over 45 at no cost to them. Those with no insurance will be seen at no cost to them.
