WHEREAS, H2M Group, consulting engineers to the Riverhead Water District, by attached letter dated December 16, 2020 did recommend that the bid be awarded to Harper Haines Fluid Control, Inc. for the total bid amount of \$74,720.96 for the period of January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to this bid award, the Town Supervisor be and is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Harper Haines Fluid Control, Inc., and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon completion of fully executed contracts and the filing of said contract with the Town Clerk, the Town Clerk is hereby authorized to release to the successful bidder the bidder's bid security, and be it further
