TOWN OF RIVERHEAD INVITES COMMUNITY TO SHOW SUPPORT FOR OUR “HOMETOWN HEROES”

On Friday, April 23, 2021, Councilman Ken Rothwell, liaison to the Veteran’s Advisory Committee, will join the committee, the Riverhead BID and the entire Town Board, to proudly unveil banners, each highlighting a Veteran from the Town of Riverhead, as part of their “Hometown Heroes Banner Project”. The ceremony will take place in front of 112 West Main Street (Cucina 25), just west of Roanoke Avenue at 12:00 p.m.

Town Supervisor, Yvette Aguiar encourages Riverhead residents of all ages to attend Friday’s ceremony to “honor and celebrate the lives of heroes from our own community”.

The project honors local Veterans, serving in all branches of the United States armed forces. The banners will be prominently displayed along Main Street during the months of April through June in observance of Memorial Day, and again, during September through November, in observance of Veteran’s Day. Councilman Rothwell stated, “I look forward to continue working with the Veteran’s Advisory Committee to properly honor and assist our local servicemen and servicewomen.”
