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Supervisor Cardinale: "Okay, this is the- Okay? This is the May 16th meeting of the town board which actually was supposed to be on May 15th but my Deputy can't count. We were supposed to move it to this location on last night, Tuesday, because the Board of Assessment Review was holding the meeting in the town hall. There is absolutely no reason that we should be here tonight that I know because the town hall board room- so we moved it a day and put it in a different location.

So we're going to begin the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and Vince is going to lead us if he remembers the words."

(At this time the Pledge of Allegiance was recited, led by Vince Tria).

Supervisor Cardinale: "We're going to go down and present a proclamation. Good. Works. Okay, as we begin this evening, I was informed that this is- where did my people go- my- oh, there they are. I'm looking at the seat- I was informed that this is Salvation Army Week and we wanted to present a proclamation in honor of all the work the Salvation Army does in this area and we have Director Paul Vincent and Captain Paula- I get that- Collette Masom (phonetic). Okay. Paul Vincent and Collette Masom, Captain Collette.

This proclamation indicates as follows:

Whereas, the Salvation Army's only business in this community of Riverhead as everywhere is human business undertaken with the joy for the family of humankind; and

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Whereas, through sound, innovative and professional services, the Salvation Army serves the people of the town of Riverhead with unshakeable faith in all; and

Whereas, no matter how desperate the situation, the Salvation Army views all people as people possibilities; and

Whereas, the Salvation Army always acts on behalf of all the residents of our community expecting no thanks and welcoming community support.

Be it resolved, that I, Philip Cardinale, Supervisor of the town of Riverhead on behalf of all the residents and the entire town board proclaim the period of May 14 to the 20, Salvation Army Week.

And I'd like to present that to you on behalf of the board and I'd like to turn this around- give you that and ask you- "

Collette Masom: "Okay. Well, thank you very much. Yeah, this is the national week but every week is Salvation Army week here in Riverhead. Our building is on Osborne Avenue across from the library, not to be confused with the thrift store and I just want to tell you quickly what we're doing over there.

We have an emergency food pantry, we have a soup kitchen. Every day in the winter, every day we open for the homeless after they were dropped at the train station by Maureen's Haven (phonetic)- they were out there from about 7:30 to nine to wait for the town to wake up so we opened every single morning to let them in, including Christmas and New Year's Day.

We have programs for kids at risk and we're doing a whole bunch of stuff. We're involved with the addicted, trying to get them off the streets into some of our rehabs and so it goes. But there is a lot more to do and I thank all of you because you all support us in those kettles and volunteer work, so we really appreciate it.

Thank you very much."

It would currently- the rental code currently presumes the existence of two meters to show two residential units within a dwelling. So it makes those two provisions consistent."

Councilman Bartunek: "Yes. It's hard to believe that somebody could go on to greener fields."

Supervisor Cardinale: "And we thank Billie Jo for her years of service, seven years, I think. And I vote yes."

Barbara Grattan: "The resolution is adopted."

Councilman Densieski: "Appoints a civil engineer to the engineering department. So moved."

Councilman Bartunek: "And seconded."

Supervisor Cardinale: "Moved and seconded. Vote please."

The Vote: "Dunleavy."

Councilman Dunleavy: "We've been waiting a long time for another engineer. I vote yes."

The Vote (Cont'd.): "Bartunek, yes; Densieski, yes; Cardinale, yes. The resolution is adopted."

Councilman Bartunek: "Reappoints legal representation for zoning board of appeals and board of assessors. So moved."

Councilman Dunleavy: "And seconded. And this is quite an increase in the-- "

Supervisor Cardinale: "It is."

Councilman Dunleavy: "The reason we have the increase is because we changed one member of the zoning board of appeals who wrote these--their findings up for nothing and now we have to pay to have them written. So I second it."

Supervisor Cardinale: "Moved and seconded. Vote please."

The Vote: "Dunleavy, yes; Bartunek, yes."

Councilman Densieski: (Inaudible). Yes."

The Vote (Cont'd.): "Cardinale."

Supervisor Cardinale: "Actually, the only difference between last year is 1500 a month where previously it was 750. The rest remains the same. I did speak to DeSimone and he did indicate that he was going to raise his fees anyway because he says he spent more hours last year than the 750 covered. So I'm not so sure the premise is correct but if we want the service through the end of the year, this is what we're going to have to pay. I vote yes."

Barbara Gratta: "The resolution is adopted."

Councilman Dunleavy: "Appoints a part time assistant recreation leader skate park level II to the recreation department. So moved."

Councilman Densieski: "Second the motion."

Supervisor Cardinale: "Moved and seconded. Vote please."

The Vote: "Dunleavy, yes; Bartunek, yes; Densieski, yes; Cardinale, yes. The resolution is adopted."

Councilman Densieski: "If there's no objection by the board, I'd like to move 469, 470 and 471. They are all appointments to the recreation department. So moved."

Councilman Bartunek: "And seconded."

Supervisor Cardinale: "Moved and seconded. Vote please."

The Vote: "Dunleavy, yes; Bartunek, yes; Densieski, yes; Cardinale."

Supervisor Cardinale: "Yeah. I'd like to point out that there are hires taking place tonight and will be in the next month for kids 15 and over to serve as beach attendants and lifeguards and generally assisting the recreation department. I think they have 90 during the summer. I'd like-- I recognize a lot of these names because all the parents work for us. I'd like to spread the wealth. I've asked several of the reverends to make announcements to get the kids 15 to 18 and beyond. Some of the kids are college kids, to apply so we can-- and we need more people. So, please, apply. It's on the internet, it's on channel 22. We're doing our best to broaden the harvest. I vote yes."

Barbara Grattan: "The resolutions are adopted."

Resolution #472

Councilman Densieski: "Appoints account clerk typist in the accounting department. So moved."

Supervisor Cardinale: "Moved and seconded. Before we move this, wasn't this one we discussed that we were considering tabling because this may not have three votes at this moment?"

Councilman Bartunek: "I was going to suggest that we-- I'd like to make a motion that we do table Resolution 472."

Supervisor Cardinale: "At least you made it before we voted on it."

Councilman Bartunek: "Yes."

Supervisor Cardinale: "Okay. We have a motion to consider it and a motion to table."

Councilman Dunleavy: "I don't understand-- a question. Can I?"

Supervisor Cardinale: "Yeah, go right ahead."

Councilman Dunleavy: "They need this person in the accounting department. We took a person out of the-- a full time person out of the accounting department and placed her where we had a part time person. So I don't understand why we can't replace the full time person we had in the accounting department and we have to table it to discuss it."

Supervisor Cardinale: "Well, go ahead and have a vote then but George, why don't you-- "

Councilman Bartunek: "I was going to make a suggestion that we have our executive session first tomorrow to discuss this at that time and then we are going to have a resolution possibly at the special board meeting."

Supervisor Cardinale: "Okay. And to answer your question so it isn't a mystery. You're right. The accounting department needs a full time account clerk typist, no question. The question is do we want to hire one or do we want to move somebody who may be doing a part time job to the full time position and then hire a part timer. So that's what we want to discuss."

Because, although accounting may need a full timer, we could also transfer someone into accounting and then replace that someone with a part timer elsewhere. At least that's the proposal."

Councilman Dunleavy: "Okay, I just- I think that the person that you think is doing a part time job now is doing a full time job and if she doesn't do it there, then the mechanics have to do it and then we're taking them away from fixing the cars and trucks to do paperwork. And I really don't feel that that's appropriate right now."

Supervisor Cardinale: "Okay. That was also a part time job incidentally. The person that is the ACT to the garage was the ACT to the garage and the highway at one time, which is my proposal to return to that. But the key to this is we need three votes to do anything and we all agree that the ACT is necessary in the accounting department- is whether we're going to hire a new one or transfer another one and hire a part timer. So, with that discussion- but we don't have three votes at the moment, do we?"

Councilman Densieski: "I would support it but if you want to discuss it tomorrow, I have no problem with that."

Supervisor Cardinale: "Okay, well then let's consider it tabled. George, you have a motion to table?"

Councilman Bartunek: "I'll make a motion to table Resolution 472- "

Supervisor Cardinale: "For further discussion acknowledging that we need a person in there. And Eddie is seconding it for further discussion tomorrow and let's hear if we have three votes to do that."

The Vote: "Dunleavy, yes; Bartunek, yes; Densieski, yes for more discussion; Cardinale."

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Supervisor Cardinale: "Yes. And we'll try and resolve it tomorrow morning."

Barbara Grattan: "Okay. That resolution is tabled."

Councilman Bartunek: "Phil, could I ask you? I know that we do this on an annual basis."

Supervisor Cardinale: "Yeah, this is-- "

Councilman Bartunek: "I was going to actually call Mike-- didn't have time-- "

Supervisor Cardinale: "Yeah, I did talk to him. I asked him the same thing-- great minds in the same direction. A couple of them we've done the same thing. I called him, I said why would I want to get authorization to execute an agreement. This is supposed to get us money back from the irrigation project, that's what it's for. Which we, I think, are making a commitment of 100,000 or so to irrigate water on the golf course and it trickles down and it cleans up the estuary because it filters before it goes into the estuary. And this application will get us something like 80,000."

Councilman Bartunek: "Authorizes the supervisor to execute wastewater reuse contract with the New York Department of Environmental Conservation - Contract No. C302561 for the sanitary wastewater reuse phase I-STP grounds implementation project Riverhead sewer district. So moved."
