**Sense Resolution In Support
Of License Agreement Between
The County Of Suffolk And The "Peconic YMCA"**

Councilwoman Barbara Blass offered the following resolution,
which was seconded by **Councilman Ed Densieski**

WHEREAS, the "Peconic YMCA" committee has been working for the past three years to identify a suitable location for a regional recreational facility serving both the North and South Forks, and;

WHEREAS, the "Peconic YMCA" committee has researched several parcels in public and private ownership in the Towns of Riverhead and Southampton, and,

WHEREAS, due to its location on Route 105, and existing, improved access from said highway in both the northerly and southerly directions, and the availability of public water, a parcel of County owned land has emerged as a preferred site, and,

WHEREAS, this site of approximately 17 acres, more particularly described as a portion of SCTM# 600-112-2-2.2 exists as an isolated parcel having been severed from Indian Island Park upon the construction of County Route 105, and,

WHEREAS, clearing of the parcel would be restricted to that which is necessary for site improvements, and,

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Parks for Suffolk County has encouraged this location for the "Peconic YMCA", as it would augment the existing County recreational uses in the vicinity, and,

WHEREAS, State Senator Kenneth P. LaValle has agreed to facilitate and coordinate the necessary alienation legislation at the State level,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead does hereby formally support an agreement between the County of Suffolk and the "Peconic YMCA" to site a gymnasium and pool facility on land depicted on the attached survey by Young and Young dated May 13, 2002, using private donations and State grant monies, and

BE IT FURTHER, RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be and is hereby authorized to forward a certified copy of this resolution to New York State Senator Kenneth P. LaValle, Suffolk County Executive Robert Gaffney, Suffolk County Legislature Presiding Officer Paul Tonna, Legislator Michael Caracciolo, Henry Barton, the Clerk of the Suffolk County Legislature, Suffolk County Parks Commissioner Peter Scully, the Suffolk County Parks Trustees, Joseph van de Wetering, and the Riverhead Town Attorney's Office.
