

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held in the office of Justice Hildreth Saturday, May 1, 1909 at 2.30 o'clock, p. m.

A petition was presented signed by a number of taxpayers, requesting that the Town Board make provision for furnishing an all-night light service for the streets of the Riverhead Lighting District.

On motion the petition was received and Supervisor Homan was appointed a committee to confer with the Lighting companies and ascertain what arrangement could be made to give the village an all-night service.

The matter of appointing a Town Board of Audit was taken up.

Two petitions signed by a number of taxpayers was presented, requesting that Messrs. Robert P. Griffing, Otis G. Pike and Orvis H. Luce be appointed as such Board of Audit.

These names, together with those of Vernon H. Downs and Edwin D. Fishel, were presented and the Board proceeded to ballot.

Justice Hildreth was appointed Teller and Mr. Homan Judge.

The result of the balloting was as follows:

Messrs. Griffing, Downs and Fishel were declared duly elected as the Town Board of Auditors
