

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held in the office of Justice Hildreth Friday, May 14, 1909 at 3.30 o'clock p. m.

Supervisor Homan presented his bond of \$30,000 for highway funds, which on motion was accepted.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the Highway Commissioner of the town of Riverhead be and hereby is authorized and empowered to sprinkle the Main road in the town of Riverhead with oil, commencing opposite the house of Chas. Hempstead on west Main street and extending east to the east town line of said town along the Main road and that the money required for such work hereby authorized shall be taken from the Dog Fund and Excise Fund of said town, said oiling outside the village of Riverhead not to exceed 16 feet in width.

On motion the Highway Commissioner was requested

to procure bids for furnishing the oil in carload lots.


On motion the Town Clerk was authorized to purchase a new town safe for use in the Town Clerk's office at a cost not to exceed \$250.

On motion the Town Clerk was authorized by consent of the Town Board to purchase all necessary furniture and supplies for the Town Clerk's office of said town pursuant to section 85 of the Town Law.

The Board proceeded to organize as a Board of Health by electing Supervisor Homan Chairman and Town Clerk Hagen Secretary.

On motion S. Terry Hudson was made Citizen Member and Gilbert B. Lane Health Inspector.
