

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held
in the Town Clerk's office Saturday, June 26, 1909.

On motion the sum of \$75, or as much thereof as may
be necessary, was appropriated from the Highway Fund for
the purpose of repairing the Town Dock.

On motion the sum of \$50 was appropriated for use on
Edwards Avenue for improvements.

On motion the sum of \$100, or as much thereof as may
be necessary, was appropriated for improvements to the bridge
at Upper Mills.

On motion the Supervisor was authorized to expend
whatever amount is necessary to pay balance of bills for
road oil from the Highway Fund, there not being enough
money in the Dog Fund to defray the expense.

On motion the Highway Commissioner was authorized to
lay on the roads whatever oil residents of the town see fit
to purchase.

On motion the Town Clerk was instructed to have notices posted in the village of Riverhead calling attention to the firing of fire crackers in said town.

On motion the Town Clerk was instructed to have ~~##~~ notices published in the local papers calling attention to the ordinance relating to the riding on the sidewalks of bicycles in the town of Riverhead and that such ordinance will be enforced after July 1, 1909.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
