

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Clerk's office Friday, Sept. 10, 1909 at 3 o'clock p. m.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the Town Clerk be instructed to publish the usual Election Notice in the local papers for the usual length of time.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

An acte to license and regulate circuses, shows, venders, etc. in the Town of Riverhead.

The authority to pass this resolution is found in chapter 332 of the Laws of 1890.

Sec. 1—On and after the 16" day of September, 1909 it shall not be lawful for any traveling circus or show to exhibit in the town of Riverhead until a license has been obtained form the Town Board.

Sec. 2—Such license to expire at midnight on the day for which such license is issued will be granted on payment of such a fee as three members of the Town Board shall deem

just and proper.

Sec. 3--Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be liable to a penalty of twenty-five (\$25) dollars.

Clerk is instructed to have this ordinance published in the local papers for four weeks.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the Sheriff be authorized to appoint three special officers to act in the village of Riverhead during the four days of Fair from 10 p. m. to 5 a. m. at a compensation of \$3.00 per night.

On motion Lorimer M. Raynor was appointed Attendance Officer in and for the Town of Riverhead at \$2.00 per day and five cents per mile for each and every mile traveled

On motion the Justices of the Peace were allowed to charge mileage at five cents per mile for each and every mile traveled in attending Town Board meetings.

An opinion from Counselor N. O. Petty relative to the payment of the amount due the Fire District as their share of the Bank Tax paid the Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead, was presented. In the opinion the Counselor states that in his judgment the Fire District is entitled to its share of the Bank Tax paid the town during the years 1907-08 and amounting to \$410.90 and recommends that the Town Board

adopt a resolution instructing the Supervisor to pay over that amount to the Fire District from the General Fund.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the Supervisor be instructed to transfer from the General Fund of the Town the sum of \$410.90 to be paid to the Fire District of the Town of Riverhead, that being its share of the Bank Tax.

Counselor Robert P. Griffing, Chairman of the Board of Town Auditors, appeared before the Board in reference to the Assessors' bills in which charges are made for horse hire incurred in viewing the property of the town.

Upon motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the Board of Assessors be allowed a sum not to exceed \$75 per year for horse hire incurred in viewing property of the town in their duties as Assessors.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the amount of money now in reserved in the Highway account or as much thereof as may be necessary be expended for the general maintenance of the Highways of the town.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
