Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, duly adopted on the 20th day of October, 1924, sealed bids will be received by the said Town Board and the Superintendent of Highways on Monday, November 10, 1924, at two o'clock in the afternoon, at the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Riverhead, for the paving with concrete of the northerly and southerly sides of Main street, Riverhead, New York, between the curb and the concrete road bed now under construction known as the Riverhead-Mattituck Highway, for a distance along said street from the intersection of the easterly side of Peconic avenue and Main street and the intersection of the easterly side of Cat Alley and Main street, in accordance with estimates, plans and specifications to be furnished by the County Superintendent of Highways which will be found on file in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Riverhead.

Any contract awarded will be made with the lowest responsible bidder.

No contract will be awarded unless approved by the County Superintendent of Highways.

The contractor will be required to give a good and sufficient bond in the sum of one-half the contract price, conditioned for the faithful performance of the contract, and the plans and specifications, and the payment of any damage which may accrue to the town by reason of a violation thereof.

Any information with reference to the requirements hereof may be obtained at the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Riverhead.

The right to reject any and all bids is hereby reserved.
