

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Office of the Town Clerk in said Town on Wednesday, May 12th. 1926 at 2 P.M.

Town Superintendent of Highways Charles O. Downs was present.

The minutes of the meeting of April 28th. were read and on motion approved.

Counselor Cecil B. Tooker and Dr. George W. Roesch addressed the Board about the proposed referendum on Sunday Moving pictures in the Town of Riverhead.

The opinion of Bernard H. Lord as Town Counsel was that the Town Board did not have the legal right to hold a referendum on the question of Sunday Moving Pictures in the Town.

On motion and vote, it was decided that the opinion of counsel be accepted and the matter of a referendum on the question of Sunday Moving Pictures, be laid on the table.

Supervisor Howell advised the Board that he was unable to carry out the motion of the meeting of April 28th. to retire eleven of the latest Bonds of the Riverhead - Mattituck Highway issue, as there is no record of the holder of these Bonds, the Bonds being coupon bonds.

On motion and vote the resolution of the meeting of April 28th. 1926, voting to retire eleven of the latest Highway Bonds of the Riverhead-Mattituck issue, with the refund from the State Comptroller, was rescinded.

On motion and vote, it was decided to establish a Sinking Fund of the \$11,084.20 refund from the Comptroller at 4 1/2 % interest to retire Bonds at a later date.

An opinion of B. H. Lord, as Town Counsel was read regarding the proper way to pay H. Nelson Smith for Services and Supplies for the Highway in the year 1923.

On motion and vote, the Town Board recommended that Mr. Smith submit this bill to the Town Board of Audit in the proper form.

An opinion of B. H. Lord, as Town Counsel, was read, relative to the establishment of a Highway Line on Main Street. The opinion of Counsel was, that nothing could be done legally to establish such a Highway Line, except through the usual proceedings of a Commission.

On motion and vote, it was RESOLVED, that the Supt. of Highways take the necessary steps to have a definite Highway Line established on Main Street from the Railroad Tracks at East Main Street to whatever point this road is now laid out, west of Riverhead.

Town Supt. of Highways Charles O. Downs advised the Board that he desired the Board to meet on Tuesday May 18th. for the purpose of inspecting the Town Highways.

On motion and vote it was decided that the Board would meet at the Office of the Town Clerk on May 18th. at 10 o' clock for the purpose of inspecting the Town Highways.

The <sup>meeting</sup> adjourned to meet at the the Town Clerk's Office for the next regular meeting on May 26th. at 2 P.M. and to meet May 18th. 1926 at 10.00 A. M.
