RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be and is hereby authorized to publish and post the below Notice of Public Hearing with regard to the deletion of Chapter 22 of the Riverhead Town Code, Local Law #1-1964.

LOCAL LAW #1-1964

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that a public hearing will be held on the 4th day of May, 1982, at 7:45 P.M. o'clock at the Riverhead Town Hall, 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, New York, to hear all interested persons with regard to the proposed local law deleting Chapter 22 of the Riverhead Town Code, Local Law #1-1964, entitled "Local Laws, Adoption of", a copy of which is detailed as follows:

§22-1.--Public-Hearing-required;-notice.

No-local-law-shall-be-adopted-by-the-Town-Board-of-the-Town of-Riverhead-until-a-public-hearing-has-been-held-thereon-in-its final-form-before-such-Town-Board-not-less-than-three-(3)-nor more-than-thirty-(30)-days-after-public-notice-has-been-given of-the-time-and-place-of-the-holding-of-such-public-hearing.--Such notice-shall-be-given-by-the-Town-Clerk-by-causing-the-same-to be-published-once-in-the-official-newspaper-of-the-town.--Such notice-shall-contain-the-title-of-the-proposed-local-law-and-a brief-explanatory-statement-thereof.

§22-2.--Posting-of-copy-of-proposed-local-law.

The-Town-Clerk-shall-cause-copies-of-such-proposed-local-law-to-be-printed-or-otherwise-reproduced-and-shall,-not-later-than the-day-such-notice-of-public-hearing-is-published,-post-one-(1) such-copy,-together-with-the-notice-of-hearing,-on-the-signboard at-his-office,-and-shall-also-make-copies-of-such-proposed-local law-available-at-his-office-for-inspection-by-and-distribution to-any-interested-person-during-business-hours.

§22-3.--Posting-and-Publication-following-adoption.

The-Town-Clerk-shall-forthwith-upon-the-adoption-of-a-local law-by-the-Town-Board-post-a-copy-thereof-on-the-signboard-at his-office-and-shall,-within-(10)-days-after-such-adoption,-cause the-local-law-or-an-abstract-thereof-describing-the-same-in-general terms-to-be-published-in-the-official-newspaper-of-the-town.

§22-4.--Filing-of-proofs-of-publication.

Proof-of-publication-of-the-notice-of-public-hearing-required-by-§22-1-hereof-and-proof-of-the-posting-and-publication-required-by-§22-3-hereof-shall-be-filed-in-the-office-of-the-town-Clerk.

§22-5.--Numbering;-filing-of-certified-copies.

Each-local-law-shall-be-numbered-consecutively-beginning-with number-one-(1)-for-each-calendar-year.--When-a-local-law-is-finally adopted-and-certified-copies-thereof,-as-required-by-Section-27-of-the-Municipal-Home-Rule-Law,-are-filed-in-the-offices-of-the-Town-Clerk,-the-State-Comptroller-and-the-Secretary-of-State,-the-Town Clerk-shall-accordingly-assign-to-such-local-law-the-appropriate Number.
