RESOLUTIONS

Town Justice Zaloga offered the following resolution which was seconded by Town Justice Costello.

RESOLUTIONS

WHEREAS, Shepard M. Scheinberg, was duly appointed Town Attorney of the Town of Riverhead for the term of office commencing January 1, 1964 to December 31, 1965 and thereafter re-appointed for a term commencing January 1, 1966 and ending December 31, 1967; and

WHEREAS, Shepard M. Schienberg has consented to continuing in the position of acting Town Attorney until, but not including, the first February 1968 meeting of the Riverhead Town Board at a salary of \$833.33 to be paid bi-weekly, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Shepard M. Scheinberg, be and is hereby appointed as Acting Town Attorney until, but not including, the first February 1968 meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead at a salary of \$833.33 to be paid bi-weekly.

**AGREEMENT** made this day of , 1967, by and between the RIVERHEAD YACHT CLUB, INC., a membership corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York with its principal office at Riverhead, New York, (P. O. Box ) hereinafter referred to as the tenant, and the TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, a municipal corporation organized and existing pursuant to the Town Law of the State of New York, with its principal office at 220 Roanoke Avenue, Riverhead, New York, hereinafter referred to as the landlord.

The landlord herewith leases to the tenant and the tenant herewith accepts the leasehold of the premises described on Schedule A annexed hereto, and as further illustrated on a certain survey annexed hereto as Schedule B, owned by the landlord at South Jamesport in the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, for the term of thirty (30) years, commencing from the date hereof, upon the following terms and conditions and consideration:

1. Said leasehold is subject to an easement and right of way to lay an underground storm sewer, drain or pipe line, to be granted by the Town of Riverhead, as illustrated on the survey annexed hereto as Schedule B.

Police Chief Grodski asked Mr. Horton to advise the Police Department of any such future incidents.

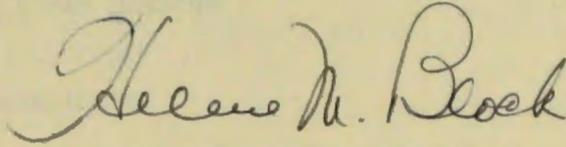
