

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, October 6, 1937 at 9:00 A. M.

William H. Clark, Supt. of Highways was present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on September 29, 1937 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from Mrs. George C. Miller making a complaint on the time that the street lights are turned off in the morning. The communication was ordered placed on file and the Town Clerk was directed to acknowledge same and advise that the matter is being investigated.

A petition signed by approximately 150 taxpayers of the Town of Riverhead requesting the Town Board to reduce the salaries of the Town officials, was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote the petition was ordered placed on file.

The matter of the sidewalk in front of the Ludlum property, West Main Street, Riverhead was discussed by the Board and on motion of Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Luce, it was RESOLVED that the matter be tabled for future consideration. The vote, Justices Warner, Bouthcher, Kelly and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Luce, it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to transfer the sum of \$100.00 from the Town Park Maintenance Account to the Machinery Item #3-Highway Account and the sum of \$312.68 from the Town Park Maintenance Account to the General Repairs Item #1, Highway Account. The vote, Justices Warner, Bouthcher, Kelly and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The matter of the appropriation of \$50.00 to the East End Surf Fishing Club for publicity work in connection with their booth at the Annual Sportsman's Club Show held in the Grand Central Palace, New York was discussed by the Board. Town Attorney Wiley advised that the Board, according to law, has a right to appropriate money for publicity work, but it has no right to appropriate money for that purpose through any private Club or Institution, and can only be done by permissive referendum.

Due to the fact that some of the budgets from the outlaying School Districts were not in, on motion and vote the meeting recessed to reconvene on Saturday, October 9, 1937 at 9:00 A. M.
