

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, August 18, 1943 at 2:00 P. M.

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held on August 4, 1943 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Notice of Public Hearing on the application of Henry W. Adelwerth for a franchise to operate a motor bus route over certain highways within the Town of Riverhead was read.

Proof of publication of said notice was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

Supervisor Kelly, thereupon declared the hearing duly open and anyone wishing to be heard could do so at this time.

On motion made by Justice Boutcher and seconded by Justice Smith, it was RESOLVED that the said Hearing be adjourned to September 15, 1943 at 2:00 P. M. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A communication was read from Mrs. Alice Miller Hart, Acting Welfare Officer of the Town of Riverhead, stating that she had recently tendered her resignation as Acting Welfare Officer and Case Worker, effective August 31, 1943 and in view of unforeseen developments in her personal affairs, she would like to withdraw her resignation and if it is the Town Board's pleasure, continue in that capacity. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED that the resolution adopted by the Town Board on August 4, 1943 accepting the resignation of Mrs. Alice Miller Hart as Acting Welfare Officer and Case Worker be and the same is hereby rescinded. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A communication was read from Ellis T. Terry, County Treasurer, stating that his office will have many requests from various bonding companies for satisfaction of Receiver's Bonds on 1942-43 tax collections and would appreciate if his office was advised whether or not there is any objection on the part of the Town of Riverhead to the issuance of such satisfaction. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Smith and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was RESOLVED that there is no objection on the part of the Town of Riverhead to the satisfaction of the Tax Receiver's Bond on the 1942-43 Tax Collections, provided the audit by the County Treasurer shows no objection thereto. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

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
On motion made by Justice Boutcher and seconded by Justice Warner, it was RESOLVED that Mrs. Ella Cheshire be appointed Special Clerk to the Board of Assessors effective August 19, 1943 and that her salary be fixed at the rate of \$4.00 per day. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Leonard and Smith, Yes, Supervisor Kelly, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED that Robert Leonard be and he hereby is appointed Special Policeman for the Town of Riverhead, effective as of this date and that his salary be fixed at the base rate of \$1800.00 per year, payable, semi-monthly. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Leonard and Smith, Yes, Supervisor Kelly, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Supervisor Kelly submitted his report for the month of July, 1943 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the Town bills for the month of July, 1943.

There being no further business on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, September 1, 1943 at 2:00 P. M.
