

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held at the Town Hall, Riverhead, New York, on Tuesday, March 26th, 1968 at 10:30 A.M.

The meeting was called to order at 10:30 A.M., by Supervisor Vojvoda.

Town Justice Costello offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Young.

RESOLVED, That the Minutes of the Meeting of the Town Board held in the Town Hall on March 19, 1968, be approved as submitted.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Town Justice Zaloga, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

REPORTS

After being duly advertised a sealed bid for a revocable license to operate the Jamesport Marina was opened by the Town Clerk on Monday, March 25th, 1968 at 11:00 A.M. as follows:

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The bid was filed for the March 26, 1968 Town Board Meeting.

Riverhead Town Planning Board, dated March 22, 1968, submitting recommendation and report relating to petition of Riverhead Building Supply Co. for change of zone use district from Res. 2 to Industrial 1 of a parcel of 1/3 acre fronting on Corwin St., Riverhead, N. Y., said report recommending that the Town Board deny the petition of Riverhead Building Supply Co. Filed.

COMMUNICATIONS continued:

Russell Meier and Family, thanking Town Board for donation to History Scholarship Fund in memory of Evelyn Meier. Filed.

State of New York, Dept. of Transportation submitting following Notices of Action dated March 15, 1968:

1. (2) The following county road is exclusive<sup>41</sup> from the above 30 MPH area speed regulation:

(I) Northville Turnpike, CR 43, between Oliver Street and CR 58.

The above action is to be effective upon completion.

This action excludes that section of Northville Turnpike where the Town of Riverhead will post a 40 MPH linear speed limit. This completion notice must be returned when the one is returned for the posting of the 40 MPH speed limit.

2. (a) 30 MPH within the Riverhead area, the boundaries of which are described in Paragraph (1), exclusive of the county road listed in Paragraph (2).

The above action is to be effective upon completion.

This action is taken in conjunction with the exclusion of a section of Northville Turnpike from the area-wide 30 MPH speed limit in the Riverhead area.

B. (f) 40 MPH on Pulaski Street, a town highway, between CR 58 (Old Country Road) and a point 600 feet north of Raynor Avenue, a distance of 1.0 plus miles in the unincorporated community of Riverhead.

(g) 40 MPH on Northville Turnpike, CR 43, between Oliver Street and CR 58, distance of 0.4 plus miles in the unincorporated community of Riverhead.

The above action is to be effective upon completion.

This action establishes 40 MPH speed limits on the above highway as requested by a joint request from the Town Board and the County Commissioner of Public Works.

The communications were placed on file.

Copies to Town Board and Police Chief.

At this point of the meeting, Supervisor asked if anyone wished to be heard and the following responded:

Mr. Wickham Tyte asked when the Housing Code will be completed and ready for publication.

Supervisor Vojvoda informed Mr. Tyte that it is being drawn up by the Town Attorney and the Building Inspector and will be presented to the Board sometime in April.

Mr. Martin Isaacs asked the Board to consider proclaiming "Poppa Nick Day" in honor of Nick Meras, proprietor of the Star Confectionery.

Supervisor Vojvoda requested Mr. Isaacs to meet with him to formulate plans for proclaiming "Poppa Nick Day" in the Town of Riverhead.

Mr. Isaacs as a concerned citizen of Riverhead Town read a statement to the Town Board giving his opinion of Justice Costello's handling of a civil matter in Justice Court.

The statement was handed to the Town Clerk and placed on file.

Mr. Isaacs thanked the Town Board and the Recreation Department for tremendous recreation program facilities made available to the youth of the town of Riverhead.

RESOLUTION

Councilman Young offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Grodski.

RESOLVED, That the Superintendent of Highways be and is hereby authorized to pay snow overtime and emergency flooding compensation for a total of 246 hours the amount of \$1059.51, for the period from March 13, 1968 to March 16, 1968.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Town Justice Zaloga, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Councilman Young offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Grodski.

RESOLVED, That the bid for One (1) New Pull-Type Sweeper for use of the Riverhead Town Highway Department be and is hereby awarded to Municipal Machinery Co., Inc., Jericho Turnpike, Coram, N. Y. 11727, for the net delivered price of \$895.00, subject to the bid and specification form filed in the Office of the Town Clerk, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the acceptance of said bid is subject to the approval of the Suffolk County Superintendent of Highways/Suffolk County Commissioner of Public Works.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Town Justice Zaloga, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Councilman Young offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Grodski.

RESOLVED, That the bid for Domestic Bulk No. 1 New York State Mineral Grained Rock Salt for use of the Riverhead Town Highway Department for the period April 1, 1968 to April 1, 1969, be and it is hereby awarded to Highway Materials Co., Inc., P. O. Box 70, South Lansing, N. Y. 14850, at \$20.32 per ton for treated Rock Salt delivered and \$.21 per pound for Treatment for outside storage, subject to the specifications and bid form filed in the Town Clerk's Office, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the items and services specified shall be purchased as directed by the Superintendent of Highways.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Town Justice Zaloga, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Councilman Grodski offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Young.

RESOLUTIONS

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead to renew a Recreation Project, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Riverhead is about to submit an application for such renewal to the New York State Division for Youth for its approval, and if approved, to apply subsequently to the State of New York for partial reimbursement of funds expended on said project, as provided by Chapter 556 of the Laws of 1945, as Amended, Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that such application renewal, is in all respects approved, and Robert B. Vojvoda, Supervisor is hereby directed and authorized to duly execute and present said application renewal of the New York Division for Youth for its approval.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Town Justice Zaloga, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Town Justice Zaloga offered the following resolution which was seconded by Town Justice Costello.

BE IT RESOLVED, That Stanley Grodski, Asst. Recreation Supervisor and two members of the Recreation Committee, be and are hereby authorized to attend the 47th Annual N. Y. State Recreation and Park Conference to be held at Kiamesha Lake, N. Y., on April 21st thru 24th, 1968, and that all necessary expenses incurred thereto be paid from Recreation funds.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Not Voting, Town Justice Zaloga, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Town Justice Zaloga offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Young.

RESOLVED, That the bid for revocable license to operate the Jamesport Marina of the Town of Riverhead for the 1968 and 1969 seasons be and is hereby awarded to Arshar Corporation, P. O. Box 650, Aquebogue, N. Y. 11931, for the total bid of \$1000.00 for two seasons, half of which amount being \$500.00 is payable within 24 hours of notification of bid award, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the acceptance of said bid is subject to the bid specification and Riverhead Town Marina Regulations filed in the office of the Town Clerk.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Town Justice Zaloga, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Town Justice Costello offered the following resolution which was seconded by Town Justice Zaloga.

RESOLVED, That the Long Island Lighting Company be and is hereby authorized to make a survey for the installation of a street light on Millbrook Lane, Riverhead, N. Y.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Town Justice Zaloga, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.
