WHEREAS, The Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, has caused all matters and things to be done which are required by the Town Law and other statutes made and provided in connection with amendments of Ordinance No. 3, entitled "Traffic Control and Parking", adopted March 19, 1968,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and this Town Board hereby ordains and enacts the following amendment to said Ordinance No. 3, entitled "Traffic Control and Parking":

(1) Section 3 of Ordinance No. 3, subdivision (a), is amended by adding the following intersection:

Intersection of	with stop sign on	entrance from
Merritts Pond Road	Duryea Street	West

(2) Section 4 of said Ordinance, subdivision (a) is amended by adding a new section, as follows:

23. On the east side of Roanoke Avenue from its intersection with the north side of Route 58 to its intersection with the south side of Middle Road.

(3) Said Ordinance is amended by adding a new section, as follows:

Section 5-A PAVEMENT MARKINGS.

Application of pavement markings: Pavement markings in accordance with the standards and specifications established by the State Traffic Commission shall be applied on all town highways.

The amendments to Ordinance No. 3, entitled "Traffic Control and Parking" shall take effect ten days after publication and posting.

## CAPITAL NOTE RESOLUTION - DATED JULY 2ND, 1968

WHEREAS, The Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, New York, by resolution duly adopted the 4th day of June, 1968, authorized the purchase of a \$15,735 Automatic Tax Extension Computer with component accessories and programming for use in the Assessors Office and Supervisor's Office and by resolution duly adopted the 11th day of June, 1968, provided that \$8,235.00 of such cost of \$15,735 was to be paid from the proceeds of obligations to be issued pursuant to the Local Finance Law,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED.

1. That the specific object or purpose for which obligations are to be issued pursuant to this resolution is to finance the purchase of an Automatic Tax Extension Computer with component accessories and programming for use in the Assessors Office and Supervisor's Office, in and for said Town.

2. The balance cost of such purchase as above stated is \$8,235.00 and the plan of financing such cost is by the issuance of a Capital Note of said Town in the principal amount of \$8,235.00, pursuant to Section 32.00 of the Local Finance Law.

3. The period of probable usefulness of such purchase of the Automatic Tax Computer as aforesaid is hereby determined to be five years.

4. The Town of Riverhead hereby authorizes the issuance of its Capital Note in the amount of \$8,235.00 to finance such cost in accordance with the financial plan set forth above.

5. Such Capital Note shall be numbered 1 and shall mature in the year 1969. The power to fix and determine the date upon which such Note shall become due and payable is hereby delegated to the Supervisor. The Note shall be issued in bearer form, shall not contain a power to convert to registered form, and shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding five per centum per annum payable annually. It is hereby certified and recited that all conditions, acts and things required by the Constitution and statutes of the State of New York to exist, to have happened and to have been performed precedent to and in the issuance of this Note, exist, have happened and have been performed, and that this Note, together with all other indebtedness of such Town of Riverhead is within the every debt and other limit prescribed by the Constitution and Laws of such State.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, a public hearing will be held by the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead at the Town Hall, 220 Roanoke Avenue, Riverhead, New York, on the 16th day of July, 1968, at 10:45 A.M., o'clock, in the matter of the adoption of proposed Local Law No. 1 of 1968, known as the Housing Code of the Town of Riverhead.

The proposed Housing Code has as its purpose the adoption of basic, uniform standards governing the condition, occupancy and maintenance of residential premises, and establishing reasonable standards and safeguards for the safety, health and welfare of the occupants and users thereof.

The proposed Code provides for exceptions to its applicability; space (occupancy) requirements; structural requirements; Fire safety requirements; Equipment requirements and Property Maintenance requirements. The proposed code further defines the responsibilities of owners or occupants of residential premises, and provides procedures for its enforcement, including fine and imprisonment, eviction, reduction of rent and damages.

A complete copy of the proposed code is on file at the office of the Town Clerk and is available during regular business hours for inspection by the public.

Persons who wish to be heard on the proposed Local Law must appear at the time and place specified.
