INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Sealed proposals for the demolition, removal, filling, and regrading of various premises in Riverhead Town, New York, are required by the Town Board, Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, as set forth in the following specifications, will be opened at the Town Hall, 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, New York, at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 3, 1985.
2. No charge will be allowed for salvage.
3. No charge will be allowed for federal, state, or municipal sales and excise taxes, for which the Town of Riverhead is exempt. The price bid shall be net and shall not include the amount of any such tax. Exemption certificates, if required, will be furnished on forms provided by the bidder.
4. The Town Board reserves the right to waive any formalities in any proposal or, in its discretion, to reject all bids and re-advertise in the manner provided by Section 103 of the General Municipal Law. The Board reserves the right to accept any within 30 days of the bid opening.
5. Each bidder must execute the non-collusion certificate provided herewith and, if a corporation must submit a resolution of the Board authorizing the bid, a form is also annexed hereto.
6. These instructions are to be considered an integral part of all proposals.

7. Each bid must be presented in a sealed envelope, clearly marked "Demolition."

#614 WAIVES RESTRICTIONS OF CHAPTER 46 OF THE RIVERHEAD TOWN CODE FOR THE POLISH TOWN STREET FAIR

Councilman Prusinowski offered the following resolution, which was seconded by Councilman Artale.

WHEREAS, on August 17 and 18, 1985, the Polish Town Civic Association will sponsor the Annual Polish Town Street Fair, and

WHEREAS, the Polish Town Civic Association has requested a waiver of the restrictions as set forth in Chapter 46 of the Riverhead Town Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the restrictions as set forth in Chapter 46 of the Riverhead Town Code regarding Alcoholic Beverages be and are hereby waived as follows:

1. Said restrictions are waived only for the hours of 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on August 17, and for the hours of 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. on August 18, 1985.

2. The area where such restrictions are waived is described as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of Lincoln Avenue and Roanoke Avenue on the southwest corner thereof including all of Lincoln Avenue west of the railroad tracks at the intersection of Lincoln Avenue and Swezey Avenue:

THENCE, west along the railroad tracks to Marcy Avenue proceeding north along Marcy Avenue to the intersection of Marcy Avenue with the railroad tracks to a point 500 feet north of Pulaski Street; proceeding east 500 feet parallel to and north of Pulaski Street to Roanoke Avenue along the easterly curb of Roanoke Avenue to the point of BEGINNING at Lincoln Street.

The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.


