

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, February 14, 1929 at 8 P. M.

On motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried it is Resolved that this Board oppose the passing of the proposed bill introduced into the State Legislature for the purposes of authorizing the Town Board of Riverhead to re-convey the property deeded by Mrs. Barnes to the Town for park purposes on the ground;

1. That no notice was given to the parties particularly interested, namely, the Town of Riverhead and the Town Board of Riverhead of the introduction of this legislation and the Town Board has not had an opportunity of presenting its views to the Legislature.

2. That the recitals in the proposed act of Legislature are not in accordance with the state of facts and do not accurately represent all that was done by the Town Board in the matter of the dedication of the Town Park.

3. That the act is unnecessary because an application to the Courts of the State would determine the rights of parties and if necessary give the relief demanded or required without any special legislation on the subject.

It is hereby further Resolved that a copy of the minutes of this meeting bearing on the subject be sent to His Excellency, The Governor, with a respectful request to him to veto the special act if same is passed by the Legislature.

Complaints having been made that there has been slackness in looking after the safety of the school children by the Special Constables on duty near the schools, it is hereby RESOLVED That the Special Constables on duty at schools, be directed to stand in the middle of the highway during those periods of the day when it is necessary for the children to cross the streets and be further directed to give particular attention to the safeguarding of the school children, and

Be it further Resolved that a copy of the foregoing resolution be sent to each of the Special Constables of the Town of Riverhead.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes be and he hereby is authorized to employ a clerk to assist him with the tax books for a period of ten additional days.

On motion and vote the meeting adjourned.
