At this time, Supervisor Vojvoda asked if any one wished to be heard.

Irene J. Pendzick, Receiver of Taxes addressed the Board regarding the matter of hooking-up the Receiver of Taxes' burglar alarm to Police Headquarters.

Mrs. Pendzick informed the Board that the New York Telephone Company has submitted an estimated rate of \$12.00 per month for such hook-up and the electrician an estimate of approximately \$150.00 for the installation of line to the Police Headquarters.

Mrs. Pendzick further stated that a great deal of money is handled in the office of Receiver of Taxes and the Insurance Company has stressed that extra precautions be inaugurated to protect and ensure the safety of the funds.

After much discussion, the Town Board agreed that prudent measures be provided to safeguard the funds of the Town and granted permission to run the burglar alarm line to be connected with the Police Department.
