

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, Wednesday, April 10, 1929 at 2 P. M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board held March 27, 1929 were read and on motion and vote adopted.

Supervisor Homan advised the Board of his intention of going to Albany, N.Y. to request the Governor not to sign the escallop bill recently passed by the Assembly and Senate and requested that the Board pass a resolution authorizing the payment of his expenses by the Town of Riverhead.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the actual and necessary expenses of Supervisor Homan in connection with trip to Albany in the matter of the escallop bill be paid by the Town of Riverhead.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That this Board petition the Governor not to sign the escallop bill passed by the Assembly and Senate at the last meeting of the Legislature.

A bill was presented by the Water District in the amount of \$108.25 for services rendered by Lucas and Sanford for moving hydrants on Main Street, Riverhead, at the time of the widening of the Main Street and said bill was held over until a future meeting of the Board.

The committee in charge of the Water District Election presented a Statement of Canvass of said election held on the eighth day of April, 1929

Ellis S. Duvall by the greatest number of votes was duly elected Water Commissioner for a term of three years from April 16, 1929.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the committee appointed to locate a site for the proposed Town Hall and a site for a Town Dump, be and it hereby is authorized to hire counsel in connection with these undertakings.

WHEREAS, There now exists a vacancy in the Office of Constable of the Town of Riverhead, due to the failure of Andrew H. Prudent to qualify for said office, on motion duly made, seconded and carried it is hereby Resolved That Frank Ruskowski of Calverton, be and he hereby is appointed Constable of and for the Town of Riverhead, to fill vacancy of Andrew H. Prudent, who failed to qualify.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That this Board recommend that the Town Superintendent of Highways advertise for bids for road oil and contract for same as soon as possible.

There being no further business, on motion and vote the meeting adjourned.
