

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, July 19, 1950 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on July 5, 1950 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Mr. Joseph Bakora representing the Lions Club of Riverhead addressed the Board stating that the Club is ready and willing to help fix up a picnic ground, construct permanent fire places and furnish benches similar to those at the State Park if the Town will improve the road leading to the picnic area and fix a parking area nearby. On motion and vote the Town Board authorized the Supt. of Highways to make the necessary improvements.

A communication was read from Mr. Clarence Vail calling the Board's attention to the reckless riding of bicycles on the sidewalks of Riverhead and is concerned with the possibility of being injured. The letter was ordered placed on file and the Town Clerk instructed to acknowledge receipt of the letter, notify Mr. Vail that the matter was referred to the Police Committee.

A communication from the New York State Traffic Commission dated July 5, 1950 supplementing their letter of June 13, 1950 stating the factors developed by their investigation do not substantiate action to install a traffic signal light at the intersection of Route 25 with Wading River-Manorville Road in the Town of Riverhead. The letter was ordered placed on file.

Justice Warner offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Leonard

WHEREAS, it has been called to the attention of the Town Board of the dangerous intersections of the several avenues with New York State Highway Route 25 in the hamlet of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, due to heavy traffic and poor visibility, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of Riverhead request the New York State Traffic Commission to make a survey of the several intersections with State Highway Route 25 from Marcy Avenue on the west to Ostrander Avenue on the east in the hamlet of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, especially Marcy Avenue with Route 25, due to the heavy commercial traffic at that point, in order to alleviate the congestion of traffic and the safety of pedestrians. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.


On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Yousik it

was Resolved that the fee of \$35.00 shall accompany all applications for bus franchises in the Town of Riverhead, said amount to cover the cost of advertising and other incidental expenses in connection with the public hearings. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Supervisor's report for the month June 1950 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date, the totals of which were as follows: General Town Fund-\$2546.03, Highway Machinery Fund-\$1472.96.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, August 2, 1950 at 2:00 P.M.
