

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Wednesday, July 31, 1929 at 2 P. M.

Charles O. Downs, Town Superintendent of Highways was present.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board, held July 17, 1929 were read and on motion and vote adopted.

A petition was read from residents and owners residing on Peconic Bay Boulevard protesting against the dumping of refuse near the Boulevard between Laurel and Jamesport.

A communication was read from Rev. S. M. B. Usry of Hempstead, N.Y in reference to the trouble arising after the Carnival at the Fair Grounds.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That Byron Rogers, Clerk of the Board of Assessors, be and he hereby is authorized to hire a clerk for a period of five weeks at a weekly compensation of \$25.00

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the Town purchase land of Raymond H. Nugent near Reeves Avenue, for a town dumping ground at a price not to exceed \$800.00

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the Town proceed to condemn about 2 acres of land of Leroy Wells bordering on the Boulevard at Aquebogue for a town dumping ground.

It was moved, seconded and carried that Edwin M. Lockwood be retained by the Town Board to represent the Town in these matters.

The committee of the Town Board recommended that Cecil B. Tooker, Howard V. Lane, William N. Wells, Julian Rubenstein and Horatio Lowe be appointed Zoning Commissioners for the Town of Riverhead.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That Cecil B. Tooker be and he hereby is appointed a Zoning Commissioner of and for the Town of Riverhead for a period of one year; that Howard V. Lane be and he hereby is appointed a Zoning Commissioner of and for the Town of Riverhead for a period

of two years; that William N. Wells be and he hereby is appointed a zoning commissioner of and for the Town of Riverhead for a period of three years; that Julian Ribenstein be and he hereby is appointed a Zoning Commissioner of and for the Town of Riverhead for a period of four years; that Horatio Lowe be and he hereby is appointed a Zoning Commissioner of and for the Town of Riverhead for a period of five years.

Town Sup't. of Highways Charles O. Downs and Daniel R. Young addressed the Board relative to the proper method of draining Hamilton Avenue and Jamesport at the intersection of the Main Highways and South Jamesport Avenue.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the following places be and they hereby are designated as Polling Places for the Election Districts designated in the Town of Riverhead, for the ensuing year.
