

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office in said Town on Monday, June 7, 1926 at 2 P.M.

The minutes of the meeting of May 26, were read and on motion approved.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED, that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow the sum of \$1117.50 to pay on account of interest due on Water Bonds.

On motion and vote it was decided to convene at the Town Clerk's Office on Thursday May 10th. 1926 at 1.45 P.M. and to then attend the Public Hearing at the Court House regarding the elimination of the grade crossing at East Main Street, Riverhead.

The Supervisor was advised to borrow the \$600.00 as per resolution of meeting of February 16, 1926 to purchase strip of land belonging to Harold Robinson and Gus Kosikowski and if same was not accepted to open an interest account with same, known as the account to purchase land of Kosikowski and Robinson.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned to meet at the Town Clerk's Office on May 10, 1926 at 1.45.
