Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

The following was on motion made seconded and carried adopted by this board

REQUEST UNDER SECTION 138A FOR A WIDER OR DIFFERENT FORM OF CONSTRUCTION IN THE IMPROVEMENT OF A STATE OR COUNTY HIGHWAY WITH FEDERAL AID WITHIN A TOWN.

Town of Riverhead, County of Suffolk

RESOLUTION requesting the widening of, or a more expensive type of construction for, F. A. Highway in the town of Riverhead as provided in Article Six and Six-A of the Highway Law (Chapter 30, Laws of 1909), as amended, passed by the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead on the 25th day of March 1921, a quorum being present and six members voting in favor of such resolution and none members voting against the same.

1- Whereas the State Commission of Highways has determined to construct or improve as F.A. Highway with sixteen feet of cement concrete pavement such portions of the highways hereinafter described in Par. 2, therefore, be it

2- RESOLVED, That this Board pursuant to Article Six and Six-A of the Highway Law, requests that the plans for the improvement of the highways as described in this paragraph, be modified as provided in paragraph 3, viz: Beginning at Sta. 578-48 on the present Port Jefferson - Riverhead highway, said station being at the town line between the towns of Brookhaven and Riverhead; thence easterly and southeasterly along said highway to Sta. 756-00, said station being about 200 ft. northwesterly from the intersection of the Middle Country road, having a total length of 17714 feet as shown on reverse side of this sheet.

3- RESOLVED, That this Board requests that the aforesaid highway be constructed of the classes, lengths and widths

of pavement indicated in the following table. The said Board hereby agrees that the additional cost of same, over the Engineer's Estimate for a cement concrete pavement roadway of sixteen feet, be and hereby is a charge upon said town as provided by section 138A of the Highway Law.

<u>Class of Pavement</u>	<u>Width</u>	<u>Length</u>
Reinforced cement concrete pavement	20'	17714'

4- RESOLVED, That where this resolution provides for widening the pavement to curbs, that this pavement shall be extended back on intersecting streets to the street line with a width on street line to fit curb lines on intersecting street.

5- RESOLVED, That this Board agrees to have all sewer, gas and water mains and connections therewith laid in said street prior to the date of the award of the contract for the improvement.

5- RESOLVED, That the clerk of this Board is hereby directed to forthwith transmit one certified copy of the foregoing resolution to the State Commission of Highways.


