

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, August 15, 1951 at 2:00 P.M.

William J. Hattrick, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were also present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on August 1, 1951 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from Benjamin C. Densieski, Recording Secretary of the Jamesport-South Jamesport Civic Association requesting the Town Board to give consideration to the installation of traffic signal control lights at the intersection of the railroad underpass and Main Street in the Hamlets of Jamesport and South Jamesport. Also that efforts be made to lower the bank on the southwest corner of the railroad crossing at Washington Avenue, Jamesport in order to make better visibility of trains coming from the west. The communication was ordered placed on file and the matter referred to the Highway Committee, the Supt. of Highways and Alden W. Young.

A petition signed by twelve taxpayers of the Town of Riverhead requesting that a sidewalk be layed on the east side of Fairway Avenue was submitted to the Board. They further requested that warning signs for the speed of automobiles be placed at each end of Fairway Avenue due to the fact that there are so many small children living on that street. The petition was referred to the Highway Committee and the Supt. of Highways.

A communication was read from Harry B. Ward, District Supt. of Schools advising the Board that the appointments of Norman J. Bruen and Howard A. Wells as attendance officers have been approved. The communication was ordered placed on file.

The Supervisor's report for the month of July, 1951 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved, that Ida Vail be appointed a part time Clerk in the Assessors Office to serve at the pleasure of the Board, salary fixed at the rate of \$6.00 per day, retroactive as of August 13, 1951. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik and Gatz Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved, that the easterly extensions of Ackerly Street and Hallock Street, Roanoke Heights be and they hereby are accepted as Town Highways. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved, that Dr. Peter Zuhoski of South Jamesport, New York be appointed a member of the Town of Riverhead Planning Board for a period of five years, retroactive as of January 1, 1951. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved, that the Suffolk County Civil Service Commission be requested to hold a civil service examination for the following positions:


Plant Operator - Riverhead Water District

Plant Operator - Riverhead Sewer District

The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date, the totals of which were as follows: General Town Fund-\$5,149.58, Highway Machinery Fund-\$94.06.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, September 5, 1951 at 2:00 P.M.
