
Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

By chapter 268 of the Laws of 1921, in effect April 21, 1921, no itinerant carnival, exhibition or show held outside of a regular theatre or opera house, whether within public highways or upon private property, may be held without a license from the Town Board for which the fee is not less than fifty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, the applicant for same to make affidavit setting forth the precise nature of the exhibition, and the Town Board to refuse such license unless it appears that such exhibition is free from lewd or obscene features or gambling devices or immoral pursuits.

On motion made, seconded and carried the above resolution was adopted and the fee for such exhibition was made fifty dollars.

A copy of a resolution in relation to the Day Light Savings time was received from Sound Ave. Grange #1277 and was placed on file and the Town Clerk was ordered to write to above Grange acknowledging receipt of this resolution.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
