

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Clerk's Office on September 29th. 1926 at 2 P.M.

Town Superintendent of Highways Charles O. Downs was present. Dr. Alan G. Terrell, Health Officer was present.

The minutes of the meeting of September 16th. 1926 were read and on motion adopted.

A communication received from the Riverhead Water District, advising the Board that \$7250.00 was necessary to be raised by tax for the year 1927, was read and ordered placed on file.

A communication received from the Playhouse Operating Company, Inc., in regard to Sunday Moving Pictures in Riverhead, was read and ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from the Lions Club of Riverhead requesting that action be taken prohibiting the lettering of sidewalks in front of stores with merchandise boxes, etc.

The Town Park Committee reported that they had nothing definite to bring before the Board and that this committee would meet again September 30, 1926.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow the sum of \$471.74 to pay on account of audited bills of September 28th.

Charles O. Downs, Supt. of Highways, addressed the Board and advised that he had a request for the rental of the Town Tractor and Road Breaker for two or three weeks at a rate of \$48.00 per day - the \$48.00 to include the wages of the Town Tractor Driver.

On motion and vote the Superintendent of Highways was authorized to hire out the Town Tractor and Road Breaker at a rate of \$38.00 per day, providing the Town Tractor Driver shall run the tractor, that the wages of said tractor driver shall be paid by the Contractor hiring the tractor and that said contractor shall assume all liability of the tractor and road breaker.

Mr. White of the Good Roads Machinery Company, addressed the Board in regard to a snow plow for use in connection with the Town Tractor.

The Supervisor appointed Justice Corwin and Supt. of Highways Downs to look into the matter of a snow plow and to report back to the Board.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned to meet at the call of the chair.
