

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office on October 27th. 1926 at 2 P.M.

The minutes of the meeting of Sept. 29th. were read and on motion adopted.

A communication from the Board of Education regarding a Special Constable to be on duty on Roanoke Avenue near the school house was read and ordered placed on file.

On motion and vote, the Town Board recommended that the Supervisor appoint a Special Constable to be on duty on Roanoke Avenue near the school house during the necessary hours.

A legal opinion was brought to the attention of the Board relative to the appointment of Water Commissioners in the Town of Riverhead.

The Town Clerk read and offered the following resolution, which on motion was seconded and carried: Resolved that H. Harrison Corwin be re-appointed a Water Commissioner for a term of one year; William R. Duvall for a term of Two years; and O. Edmund Griswold for a term of three years; and that their compensation be fixed at \$7.00 for attendance at a Meeting of the Commissioners, and for any and all other service in connection with the Office. These appointments to date from October 1, 1926, the beginning of the Commissioners' fiscal year

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow upon promissory note the sum of Thirty Four Hundred Ninety Two and 99/100 Dollars to pay on account of audited bills of October 26th. 1926.

The Town Park Committee reported that they had not as yet received the price on land which they are interested in.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the Compensation of the Town Clerk for Election services be and the same is hereby fixed at \$200.00 for the year 1926.

On motion and vote, the Town Clerk was authorized and directed to appoint the necessary instructors to instruct the voters in the Election Districts.

The Town Superintendent of Highways presented his estimate for moneys to be raised for Town Highway purposes and recommended that the Board approve same.

On motion duly, made seconded, and carried the following appropriations were made for the tax levy for the year 1927 for Highway purposes.

Maintenance of Bridges - - - - -	5,000.00
Machinery Fund - - - - -	15,000.00
For Removal of snow - - - - -	2,000.00
For weeds, brush, watering troughs and other purposes - - - - -	500.00
Salary & expenses Town Supt. & Deputy	6,000.00
Miscellaneous Purposes	5,000.00
