- Ross Miller: Veteran Exemption would enable more people to buy homes and in turn pay more taxes to the town. Men served for their country and now it should serve them. 1287-1288
- Stanley Krupski: Riverhead has done very little for the Veterans of the town. Now is the time to do what is right. 1288

- Richard Scott: What about P.O.W.s and M.I.A.s Some men didn't for one reason or another come back. Don't they deserve something or their at least their families. 1290
- Fran Vitollo: Veterans should be compensated for such a tragedy. 1291
- John Schwartz: Ashamed of the town for even having a discussion. 1292
- Steve Haizlip: Town went to full assessment and it may help veterans. 1293
- William Kasperovich: Tells Supervisor he violated constitution when he had him removed from the Town Board meeting. 1314-1315
