

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Wednesday, September 11, 1929 at 2 P. M.

Charles O. Downs, Town Superintendent of Highways was present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held August 29, 1929 were read and on motion and vote adopted.

A communication was read from the Barjack Realty Corporation regarding curb and gutters in front of the Colonial Arms Apartment House and same was referred to the Superintendent of Highways.

A communication was read from the Automatic Voting Machine Corporation acknowledging receipt of order for a voting machine and advising that same will be promptly shipped.

A communication was read from Herbert H. Howell advising of water running on his property following a heavy rainfall and same was referred to the Superintendent of Highways.

An opinion was presented by R. Condon Smith, regarding the land to be purchased from Raymond H. Nugent.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED, That the resolution of the Town Board dated July 31, 1929 for the purchase of land from Raymond H. Nugent be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows: Resolved That the Town of Riverhead purchase from Raymond H. Nugent a tract of land on the north side of Youngs Avenue, having an area of 5.882 acres, containing materials for use on the public highways of the Town for the agreed price of \$800.00 and be it Further Resolved, That the Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead is hereby authorized to pay the said Raymond H. Nugent for said land the sum of \$890.00 pursuant to section 51a of the Highway Law.

Carl F. Peterson, a representative of Roanoke Lodge of Odd Fellows addressed the Board as requested in reference to the rental of the new building by the Town for offices and advised that the rent for one half of the first floor would be \$2400.00 per annum or for the entire first floor \$3200.00. This matter was referred to a committee of Justice Burnside, Justice Penny and Supervisor Homan for investigation as the entire Town Board was not present.

Whereas the appointment of James Kehoe of Medford as Dog Warden has expired, on motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That James Kehoe be and he hereby is appointed Dog Warden of the Town of Riverhead, said appointment to expire December 31, 1929

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the following persons be and they hereby are appointed Inspectors of Election of the newly created Election District No. 7 of the Town of Riverhead.
