

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office on Monday, December 23, 1929 at 7:30 P.M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board held December 11, 1929 were read and on motion and vote adopted.

A petition was presented for two additional street lights within the Wading River Lighting District and said petition was referred to the Lighting Committee for investigation.

A communication received from the State Department of Health advising of the necessity of appointing a Registrar of Vital Statistics for the Town of Riverhead was read and held over until the next meeting of the Town Board.

A communication received from the Department of Agriculture and Markets advising that a dog enumerator should be appointed for the Town of Riverhead, was read and on motion duly made, seconded and carried Lorimer M. Raynor was duly appointed dog enumerator of and for the town of Riverhead.

A letter was read from the Village Clerk of Southampton advising that the traffic signal lights in Southampton were installed by the Crouse-Hinds Company of Syracuse, N.Y.

The town committee having the matter of locating suitable quarters for Town Offices advised that it had looked over the quarters in the new Odd Fellow Building and believed that the quarters were suitable and recommended that said quarters be rented by the Town.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the committee having charge of finding suitable quarters for Town Offices be and it hereby is authorized to accept the proposal of Roanoke Lodge of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows to rent the first floor of the new building at a rental of \$3200 for the first year and a 3% increase per year for the next four years.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the committee in charge of quarters for the town offices be and it hereby is authorized to employ Architect Sidney Jones to lay out the floor plan of the new offices, to accept bids for floor covering and to see that said floor covering is properly laid.

Special Constable Frank Sowinski having been injured in the performance of his duties and having been unable to work for twelve days and whereas the compensation received by said Officer Sowinski for this period is only \$17.86, on motion duly made, seconded and carried it is hereby RESOLVED That the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized to pay to Special Constable Frank Sowinski, the difference between what his actual salary would have been for the twelve days he was disabled and the amount of compensation received or the sum of \$72.14

Justice Pennymade a motion that Supervisor Homan act as Welfare Officer of and for the Town of Riverhead.

There being no further business, on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on January 3, 1930 at 2 P. M.
