

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Tuesday, February 18, 1947 at 10:00 A.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on February 5, 1947 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from Mrs Josephine M. Lord requesting that a sidewalk be laid on the north side of Elton Street. The communication was referred to the Highway Committee and the Supt. of Highways.

The Supervisors report for the month of January, 1947 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Town of Riverhead execute and deliver to Jezy and Sadie Krupski, his wife, of Manorville, a Quit-Claim Deed for all of the Town's right, title and interest in and to that portion of the Town highway known as David Terry Street lying in front of their property which was abandoned as a part of said former Town Highway in proceedings entitled, "In the Matter of the Change of location of David Terry Street - - Etc." and particularly described in said Proceedings as Parcel No.3A and that the Supervisor be authorized to execute and deliver such deed. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Justice Warner offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Yousik

WHEREAS the construction of a new town highway bridge is required at the Peconic River which is in part the boundary line between the Town of Brookhaven and the Town of Riverhead, both in Suffolk County, State of New York, on David Terry Street or River Road, where the same crosses the said Peconic River and

WHEREAS the Town of Brookhaven and the Town of Riverhead have each on their respective parts taken all proceedings and action necessary and proper to acquire the necessary lands and easements for the straightening of said David Terry Street or River Road for the purpose of constructing the approaches to said bridge in the said respective Towns and

WHEREAS it has been proposed that the Town of Brookhaven and the Town of Riverhead in connection with the construction of the said bridge and

the approaches thereto, each pay one-half of the cost of the construction of said bridge according to plans and specification therefor to be prepared by the Superintendent of Highways of the County of Suffolk, and that each of said Towns pay in full the cost of the construction of the necessary approaches to said bridge and the cost of the acquisition of rights of way therefor in each respective Town, and each Town is to construct said approaches and acquire such rights of way on their respective sides of the bridge, now therefore it is

RESOLVED, that the Town of Riverhead, in consideration of the adoption by the Town Board of the Town of Brookhaven of a resolution to the same effect and in identical terms with this resolution and in consideration of the agreement on the part of the Town of Brookhaven to the same effect, does hereby agree to pay one-half of the cost of the construction of a bridge to be constructed over the Peconic River between the Town of Brookhaven and the Town of Riverhead on David Terry Street or River Road, said bridge to be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications to be prepared by the Superintendent of Highways of the County of Suffolk, and agrees at its own expense to construct or cause to be constructed all necessary approaches to the said bridge on the Town of Riverhead side, and to acquire and pay for all necessary rights of way in connection therewith, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the cost of the construction of said bridge shall be the amount of a bid for the construction thereof in accordance with the plans and specifications to be prepared by the Superintendent of Highways of Suffolk County, accepted at a joint meeting of the Town Boards of the Town of Brookhaven and the Town of Riverhead to be held on a date and at a place to be specified in the advertisement for bids for the construction of said bridge and be it further

RESOLVED, that the agreement pursuant to this resolution be deemed to be binding upon the Town of Riverhead only when and if a resolution to the same effect containing the same terms is adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Brookhaven. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead request the New York State Department of Public Works to place a Traffic Blinker Light at the intersection of N.Y.S. Highway, Route #25 and Cedar Avenue at Aquebogue, Town of Riverhead, County of Suffolk, New York. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, March 5, 1947 at 3:00 P.M.
