

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Tuesday, February 28, 1939 at 2:00 P.M.

Lester M. Emmett, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Supervisor Homan being absent due to sickness, the Town Clerk called the meeting to order and on motion and vote, Justice Warner was duly elected chairman.

A communication was read from Miss Jean Hallock in regard to advertising again on the program "Here's Long Island" over WICC. The matter was ordered placed on the next Board calendar.

A communication from the Long Island Lighting Co. announcing the establishment of lower prices for certain sized street lamps to be effective April 1st, 1939 was read and ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from Justice Joseph V. Kelly in connection with the recent raid which was conducted by certain members of the Police Department on a gambling establishment in Riverhead.

Justice Warner acting chairman of the meeting inquired whether anyone present had anything to say in regard to the above matter.

Mr. Manny Nathan addressed the Board in regard to the above matter, stating that in view of the many rumors circulating throughout the Town he felt in fairness to those concerned, the matter should be looked into further, if any wrong had been done, those to blame should be punished, if no wrong had been done, a public apology should be put into the newspapers.

On motion and vote the above matter was deferred until the next meeting of the Town Board.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes submitted a statement of tax collections as of February 16, 1939 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the sum of \$234.19 from the General Town Surplus Account to the Accounts Payable Account. The Vote, Justices Zaleski, Warner and Boutcher, Yes, Justice Kelly and Supervisor Homan, Absent. Total Vote, Yes 3, Absent 2, No 0. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the bills for the month of February.

There being no further business on motion and vote the
meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, March 8, 1939 at 2:00 P.M.
