

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, September 15, 1943 at 2:00 P. M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on September 1, 1943, were read and on motion and vote was duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Smith and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED, that the claim of John Dombek for damages to his property adjacent to the right-of-way to the Town Parking Field off Peconic Avenue in the amount of \$15.00 be paid. Said sum is allowed pursuant to the terms of an agreement between the Town of Riverhead and the said John Dombek. The vote, Justice Warner, absent, Justices Boutcher, Leonard and Smith, Yes, Supervisor Kelly, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Absent 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Welfare Report for the month of August, 1943 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Supervisor Kelly submitted his report for the month of August, 1943 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Boutcher and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was RESOLVED that Camelia Tuthill Boggs be appointed School Traffic Officer for the Jamesport School and further

RESOLVED that she serve at the pleasure of the Town Board from the hours of 8:00 A. M. to 9:00 A. M., 11:00 A. M. to 1:00 P. M., and 3:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M., salary fixed at the rate of 65 cents per hour, effective as of September 15, 1943. The vote, Justice Warner, absent, Justices Boutcher, Leonard and Smith, Yes, Supervisor Kelly, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Absent 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Boutcher and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was RESOLVED that Robert Guy, Jr., be appointed School Traffic Officer for the Pulaski Street School and further

RESOLVED that he serve at the pleasure of the Town Board from the hours of 8:00 A. M. to 9:00 A. M., 11:00 A. M. to 1:00 P. M., and 3:00 P. M. to 4:00 P. M., salary fixed at the rate of 65 cents per hour, effective as of September 15, 1943. The vote, Justice Warner, Absent, Justices Boutcher, Leonard and Smith, Yes, Supervisor Kelly, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Absent 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A communication was read from John M. Burgess, tendering his resignation as Special Policeman, effective as of August 22, 1943. The communication was ordered placed on file.

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On motion made by Justice Boutcher and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was RESOLVED that the resignation of John M. Burgess as Special Policeman be and the same is hereby accepted. Justice Warner, absent, Justices Boutcher, Leonard and Smith, Yes, Supervisor Kelly, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Absent 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the Welfare bills for the month of August, 1943.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Tuesday, October 5, 1943 at 2:00 P. M.
