HALLOCK, FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE BY AMENDING THE "ZONING MAP OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD" BY CHANGING FROM "RESIDENCE 2" AND "FARM 1" USE DISTRICTS TO "INDUSTRIAL" USE DISTRICT A PARCEL OF LAND ON THE NORTH SIDE OF SOUND AVENUE ON THE LONG ISLAND SOUND, OFF OF HERRICKS LANE.

JUSTICE COSTELLO OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY JUSTICE ZALOGA.

RESOLVED THAT COPIES OF THE PETITIONS TO AMEND THE ZONING ORDINANCE ON A PARCEL OF LAND ON THE NORTH SIDE OF SOUND AVENUE ON THE LONG ISLAND SOUND, OFF OF HERRICKS LANE BE SUBMITTED TO THE PLANNING BOARD FOR ITS STUDY AND REPORT PRIOR TO NOVEMBER 25, 1963.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

JUSTICE ZALOGA OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BELL.

WHEREAS A PETITION DATED VARIOUSLY NOVEMBER 1ST, 2ND, 4TH AND 5TH, 1963, HAS THIS DAY BEEN PRESENTED TO THIS BOARD TO AMEND TOWN ORDINANCE No. 26 OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD BY AMENDING THE "ZONING MAP OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, SUFFOLK COUNTY, NEW YORK BY CHANGING

FROM "RESIDENCE 2" AND "FARM 1" USE DISTRICTS TO "INDUSTRIAL" USE  
A PARCEL OF LAND BOUNDED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE DIVISION-LINE BETWEEN THE LANDS OF THE BOYS CLUB OF NEW YORK AND OF GEORGE R. THORNE, WHICH SAID POINT IS DISTANT NORTHERLY 400 FEET AS MEASURED AT RIGHT ANGLES FROM THE NORTHERLY LINE OF SOUND AVENUE AND RUNNING THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING NORTHERLY ALONG THE AFORESAID DIVISION-LINE BETWEEN THE LANDS OF THE BOYS CLUB OF NEW YORK AND OF GEORGE R. THORNE TO THE MEAN HIGH WATER MARK OF LONG ISLAND SOUND; THENCE EASTERLY ALONG THE MEAN HIGH WATER MARK OF LONG ISLAND SOUND TO A POINT WHICH IS DISTANT WESTERLY 500 FEET AS MEASURED AT RIGHT ANGLES FROM THE DIVISION LINE OR PROLONGATION OF SAID DIVISION-LINE BETWEEN THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD AND THE TOWN OF SOUTHOLD; THENCE SOUTHERLY ON A LINE PARALLEL AND DISTANT WESTERLY 500 FEET AS MEASURED AT RIGHT ANGLES FROM SAID TOWN LINE TO A POINT WHICH IS DISTANT NORTHERLY 400 FEET AS MEASURED AT RIGHT ANGLES FROM THE NORTHERLY LINE OF SOUND AVENUE; THENCE WESTERLY ON A LINE PARALLEL AND DISTANT NORTHERLY 400 FEET AS MEASURED AT RIGHT ANGLES FROM THE NORTHERLY LINE OF SOUND AVENUE TO THE POINT OR PLACE OF BEGINNING.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT PURSUANT TO TOWN LAW, SECTION 265 AND ARTICLE V, SECTION 501 OF SAID TOWN ORDINANCE No. 26, A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD BY THIS BOARD AT THE TOWN HALL, ROANOKE AVENUE AND SECOND STREET, RIVERHEAD, NEW YORK ON DECEMBER 3, 1963 AT 11:00 A. M. O'CLOCK AT WHICH TIME ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND CITIZENS WILL BE HEARD BY THE TOWN BOARD AND THE TOWN CLERK IS DIRECTED TO GIVE NOTICE OF SUCH PUBLIC HEARING BY PUBLISHING A NOTICE THEREOF AT LEAST ONCE 10 DAYS PRIOR THERETO IN THE OFFICIAL TOWN NEWSPAPER.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

WHEREAS APPLICATION FOR CURBS AND GUTTERS HAS BEEN MADE BY WILLIAM KLEIN OF RIVERHEAD, NEW YORK, BE CONCRETED NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STRIP BETWEEN THE SIDEWALK AND THE CURB ADJACENT TO HIS PROPERTY ON RAILROAD AVENUE AND GRIFFING AVENUE, PURSUANT TO A CONTRACT, THE FORM OF WHICH IS HERETO ANNEXED

TOWN OF RIVERHEAD  
CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS AND GUTTERS

THIS AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK AND WILLIAM KLEIN, TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, NEW YORK, ADJACENT PROPERTY OWNERS.

THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD AGREES TO CONCRETE THE STRIP BETWEEN THE SIDEWALK AND THE CURB ADJACENT TO HIS PROPERTY ON RAILROAD AVENUE AND GRIFFING AVENUE, A TOWN HIGHWAY IN THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD.
2. THE GRADES AND LINES WILL BE ESTABLISHED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS.
3. THE MATERIALS WILL BE DELIVERED AND THE LABOR PERFORMED AT TIMES AND IN A FORM AND MANNER SPECIFIED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS.
4. THE TIME OF COMMENCEMENT AND COMPLETION OF THE WORK SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS.
5. ALL LABOR USED AND ALL MATERIALS FURNISHED SHALL CONFORM TO NEW YORK STATE SPECIFICATIONS.
6. THE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF THE AREA SHALL BE THE OBLIGATION OF THE TOWN.
7. THE ADJACENT PROPERTY OWNER, IN CONSIDERATION OF THESE PRESENTS AND OTHER CONSIDERATIONS HEREIN PERFORMED AND TO BE PERFORMED BY SAID TOWN, DO HEREWITH PAY TO THE SAID TOWN, THE SUM OF \$112.50 WHICH IS THE SUM TO REIMBURSE THE TOWN FOR THE COST OF THE MATERIALS.

THAT THE EXPENSE TO THE TOWN SHALL NOT EXCEED THE SUM OF \$190.00.

THAT THE SUPERVISOR BE AUTHORIZED TO SIGN THE SAID CONTRACT IN BEHALF OF THE TOWN WHEN THE MONEY TO BE PAID BY SAID WILLIAM KLEIN IS TURNED OVER AND THE CONTRACT HAS BEEN SIGNED BY HIM, AND THEN

THAT THE SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS BE DIRECTED TO PERFORM THE WORK.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

AN APPLICATION FOR CURBS AND GUTTERS WAS SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD FROM JANEL HOMES CORPORATION FOR CURBS AND GUTTERS ADJACENT TO ITS PROPERTY ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF ACKERLY STREET.

JUSTICE ZALOGA OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY JUSTICE COSTELLO.

WHEREAS APPLICATION FOR CURBS AND GUTTERS HAS BEEN MADE BY JANEL HOMES CORPORATION OF CALVERTON, NEW YORK, TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, NEW YORK,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT CURBS AND GUTTERS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED ALONG ACKERLY STREET ADJACENT TO THE PROPERTY OF JANEL HOMES CORPORATION, PURSUANT TO A CONTRACT, THE FORM OF WHICH IS HERETO ANNEXED

TOWN OF RIVERHEAD  
CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS AND GUTTERS

THIS AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK AND JANEL HOMES CORPORATION OF CALVERTON, TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, NEW YORK, ADJACENT PROPERTY OWNER.

THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD AGREES TO CONSTRUCT CURBS AND GUTTERS ALONG ACKERLY STREET, A TOWN HIGHWAY IN THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD.
2. THE GRADES AND LINES WILL BE ESTABLISHED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS.
3. THE MATERIALS WILL BE DELIVERED AND THE LABOR PERFORMED AT TIMES AND IN A FORM AND MANNER SPECIFIED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS.
4. THE TIME OF COMMENCEMENT AND COMPLETION OF THE WORK SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS.
5. ALL LABOR USED AND ALL MATERIALS FURNISHED SHALL CONFORM TO NEW YORK STATE SPECIFICATIONS.
6. THE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF THE AREA SHALL BE THE OBLIGATION OF THE TOWN.
7. THE ADJACENT PROPERTY OWNER, IN CONSIDERATION OF THESE PRESENTS AND OTHER CONSIDERATIONS HEREIN PERFORMED AND TO BE PERFORMED BY SAID TOWN, DO HERewith PAY TO THE SAID TOWN, THE SUM OF \$90.00 WHICH IS THE SUM TO REIMBURSE THE TOWN FOR THE COST OF THE MATERIALS.

THAT THE EXPENSE TO THE TOWN SHALL NOT EXCEED THE SUM OF \$225.00.

THAT THE SUPERVISOR BE AUTHORIZED TO SIGN THE SAID CONTRACT IN BEHALF OF THE TOWN WHEN THE MONEY TO BE PAID BY SAID JANEL HOMES CORPORATION IS TURNED OVER AND THE CONTRACT HAS BEEN SIGNED BY HIM, AND THEN

THAT THE SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS BE DIRECTED TO PERFORM THE WORK.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

AT 12:05 P. M. SUPERVISOR LEONARD CALLED A RECESS FOR LUNCH, THE BOARD TO RECONVENE AT 2:30 P. M.

AT 2:30 P. M. THE BOARD RECONVENED WITH ALL MEMBERS OF THE BOARD PRESENT.

JUSTICE ZALOGA OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY JUSTICE COSTELLO.

RESOLVED THAT PATROLMAN JOSEPH GRATTAN BE AND HE IS HEREBY GRANTED A MILITARY LEAVE OF ABSENCE FROM THE RIVERHEAD TOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT, EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 16, 1963 UNTIL COMPLETION OF MILITARY SERVICE WITH THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

JUSTICE ZALOGA OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY JUSTICE COSTELLO.

RESOLVED THAT POLICE SERGEANT ROSCOE C. PALMER, JR., BE AND HE IS HEREBY PROMOTED TO THE RANK OF POLICE LIEUTENANT AS CERTIFIED BY THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION LIST #3-158, EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 16, 1963, AT AN ANNUAL SALARY OF \$6,900.00, PAYABLE SEMI-MONTHLY.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, NOT VOTING, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

JUSTICE COSTELLO OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BELL.

WHEREAS THE TOWN BOARD REALIZES THAT IT CANNOT AND DOES NOT WISH TO INTERFERE WITH ANY DECISION ON MATTERS BEFORE THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS, BUT WISHING TO BE INFORMED OF AFORESAID MATTERS, NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS SEND EACH MEMBER OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD A COPY OF THE NOTICE OF HEARING AND A COPY OF THE DETERMINATION ON ALL APPEALS, AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE TOWN CLERK SEND A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

JUSTICE COSTELLO OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BELL.

WHEREAS MILDRED W. HUBBARD AND JOSEPH A. CONFORTI DID ON SEPTEMBER 17, 1963 PRESENT A PETITION TO THIS BOARD FOR AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE #26 OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, IN THAT IT REQUESTED AN EXTENSION OF THE INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT ALONG HUBBARD AVENUE AS SET FORTH IN SAID PETITION, AND

WHEREAS A NOTICE OF HEARING ON SUCH PETITION WAS DULY PUBLISHED, AND

WHEREAS SUCH HEARING WAS HELD ON OCTOBER 15, 1963 AT THE TOWN HALL, RIVERHEAD, NEW YORK, AND AT SUCH HEARING THE PETITIONERS APPEARED IN SUPPORT OF THE PETITION, AND A NUMBER OF ADJOINING OWNERS APPEARED IN OPPOSITION THERE TO, AND

WHEREAS AFTER DUE CONSIDERATION BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE REQUESTS SET FORTH IN SAID PETITION, AND THE OBJECTIONS THERETO, THE TOWN BOARD DOES UNANIMOUSLY CONSIDER THAT GRANTING OF SAID PETITION NOT PROMOTE THE HEALTH, SAFETY, MORALS OR THE GENERAL WELFARE OF THE COMMUNITY,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT SAID PETITION BE AND THE SAME HEREBY IS DENIED.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

THE TOWN BOARD CONVENED AS A BOARD OF AUDIT AND EXAMINED ALL TOWN BILLS TO DATE, THE TOTAL OF WHICH WAS AS FOLLOWS: GENERAL TOWN---\$15,887.30 AND MACHINERY FUND---ITEM No. 3---\$656.37.

JUSTICE COSTELLO OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WHICH WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BELL.

RESOLVED THAT THE GENERAL TOWN BILLS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,887.30 BE APPROVED AND PAID AS RENDERED.

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE MACHINERY BILLS, ITEM No. 3, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$656.37 BE APPROVED AND PAID AS RENDERED.

THE VOTE---COUNCILMAN BELL, YES, JUSTICE ZALOGA, YES, JUSTICE COSTELLO, YES, AND SUPERVISOR LEONARD, YES. THE RESOLUTION WAS THEREUPON DECLARED DULY ADOPTED.

AT 3:15 P. M. SUPERVISOR LEONARD ADJOURNED THE MEETING UNTIL 7:30 P. M. FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ADOPTION OF THE BUDGET FOR 1964.

AT 7:30 P. M. NOTICE OF BUDGET HEARING WAS READ BY THE TOWN CLERK. PROOF OF PUBLICATION AND AFFADAVIT OF POSTING SAID NOTICE OF HEARING WAS SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD AND ORDERED PLACED ON FILE.

SUPERVISOR LEONARD THEREUPON DECLARED THE BUDGET HEARING OPEN TO ANYONE WISHING TO BE HEARD FOR OR AGAINST SAID BUDGET.
