

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Tuesday, February 11, 1936 at 9:00 A. M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on January 29, 1936 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from M. H. Bidwell, Bacteriologist, of the Conservation Department in regard to the closing of Flanders and Reeves Bay. On motion and vote the communication was ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from Lithgow Osborne, Commissioner, State Conservation Department in regard to Flanders and Reeves Bays and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

Mr. John Bagshaw addressed the Board opposing the payment of any of money to Adam Schelansky for land in connection with the widening of Second Street, stating that Mr. Schelansky has no title to that strip of land.

Mr. J. Leo Saxstein addressed the Board in regard to the matter of Ralph W. Gallagher former Clerk to the Riverhead Police Department. The matter being a question of law was referred to the Town Attorney.

The Highway Committee upon the matter referred to in a communication from C. W. Ludlam, dated January 14, 1936 reported that they had investigated the matter and that the condition now existing can be eliminated at the time the Sewer pipes are laid under the sidewalk.

The matter of a separate telephone and number for the Riverhead Water District was brought to the attention of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Kelly and seconded by Justice Warner it was RESOLVED that the extension telephone of the Riverhead Water District be discontinued and a separate telephone and number be installed. The vote, Justices Warner, Butcher, Kelly and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Town Attorney Wiley reported that the deed for Green Street from John Skinkaytis has been recorded in the County Clerk's Office and that the title for same was free from all encumbrances.

The Supervisor's report for the month of January, 1936 was presented to the Board pursuant to law and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board recessed at 11:00 A.M. to reconvene at 1:00 P.M.

The Board reconvened at 1:00 P. M. as the governing body of the Riverhead Sewer District.

On motion and vote the meeting adjourned till Wednesday, February 26, 1936 at 9:00 A. M.
