

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, September 13, 1939 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on Wednesday August 30, 1939 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Affidavit of posting and proof of publications of the Ordinance defining and providing for the regulation of Tourist Camps and the Ordinance relating to junk and Auto-wrecking yards pursuant to law were submitted to the Board and ordered placed on file.

A petition signed by several taxpayers of the South Jamesport Lighting District requesting that a street light be placed on pole #6, Second St., was submitted to the Board and referred to the Street Lighting Committee.

Supervisor Homan submitted his report for the month of August 1939 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The matter in regard to the establishment of a Fire Protection District for the area of the Town of Riverhead outside of the existing Fire District was discussed by the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Butcher it was Resolved that the Town Clerk publish the following notice in the official newspaper pursuant to law.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead will hold a public hearing in the Town Hall, Roanoke Avenue and Second Street, Riverhead, New York on the 27th day of September 1939 at 2:00 P.M. on the establishment of a Fire Protection District for the entire area of the Town of Riverhead outside of the existing Fire District therein, which said existing Fire District in-so-far as the Town of Riverhead is concerned is bounded and described as follows:


Beginning at the center line of the Peconic River at a point opposite the mouth of the Saw Mill Brook, running thence in a generally northwesterly direction along the center line of the said Saw Mill Brook to a point where the same intersects the center line of Northville Turnpike, running thence north 27° 34' East 1200 ft., running thence north 62° 26' West 300 ft., running thence South 27° 34' West 1200 ft., running thence South 75° 17' West 3367.43 ft., thence running South 82° 26' West 4176.30 ft., to the center line of Osborn Av., thence South 20° 04' East 2511.16 ft., thence South 87° 06' West 6194.90 ft., thence South 4° 31' West 3469 ft. more or less to the center

line of Peconic River, and thence in a generally Northeasterly direction along the Peconic River to the point or place of beginning; said courses and distances being as shown on map made by Daniel R. Young, Surveyor, dated December 1930, and on file in the office of the Town Clerk.

At the time and place aforesaid, the Town Board will meet to consider such Fire Protection District and will hear all persons interested in the subject concerning the same.

The Resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

There being no further business, on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday September 20, 1939 at 2:00 P.M.
