Districts Nos. 7 and 8 in the Town of Riverhead  
Suffolk County New York. Notice is hereby further  
given that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead  
Suffolk County New York, will meet at the Town  
Clerk's Office in said Town on the 23d. day of April 1916  
at 2:30 o'clock P.M. to act upon said Petition.
