Minutes of ~~the~~ previous meeting read and on  
motion adopted.

On motion the following resolutions were  
passed:

Resolved: That the Health Officer of the said  
town of Riverhead be and he is hereby authorized, directed  
and empowered to expend a sum not exceeding \$1500.00, or so  
much thereof as may be necessary, to establish and  
maintain a quarantine and isolation hospital for the  
reception of patients affected with infantile paralysis,  
such hospital or quarantine station to be used for the  
reception of patients suffering from said infantile  
paralysis whose parents or guardians consent to have such  
child, or children, so maintained therein, and for the  
reception of such cases as in the judgment and discretion  
of the Health Officer, cannot be properly and safely cared  
for and quarantined in their own homes, and for the  
reception of such patients suffering from infantile  
paralysis whose parents or guardians refuse to observe or  
maintain a proper quarantine. It is further:

Resolved: That the Health Officer of the said  
town of Riverhead be authorized, directed and empowered to  
procure the appointment of a sufficient police force to  
enforce all quarantine regulations and directions of the  
Health Officer, the expenses of such police force as may  
be procured by the Health Officer to be paid from said  
fund. It is further

Resolved: That all children under the age of six-  
teen be and that same are, prohibited from attending

moving picture shows, theatres, entertainments or any other public gatherings whatever within the town of Riverhead, and that children under the age of sixteen years are hereby prohibited from entering any post office within said town.

Resolved: That cases of infantile paralysis from the adjoining town of Southold, which in the judgment of the Health Officer of the said town of Southold, he shall deem necessary to isolate and quarantine away from their homes, to a number not exceeding five at any one time, may be received and maintained in the isolation and quarantine hospital heretofore ordered and directed to be maintained by the town of Riverhead, upon payment of the said town of Southold to the said town of Riverhead of the expenses of such cases as may be treated at said hospital at the pro-rata expense of each case.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
