Supervisor Vojvoda asked if anyone wished to be heard and the following responded:

Mr. Wickham C. Tyte, Sr., addressed the Board and stated that during the last campaign the Conservative Party had gone on record as being highly critical of executive sessions and still have the same sentiment.

Mr. Tyte then read the following communication addressed to the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead:

"Dear Sirs: The Conservative Party of Riverhead respectfully requests that you discontinue the practice of transacting important Town business in Executive Town Board Meetings and make it standard procedure to have all important matters, discussed, planned, and adopted at Town Board Meetings open to the public and the press. Respectfully yours, The Conservative Party of Riverhead, signed: Wickham C. Tyte, Vice-Chairman Town Committee." (End)

The communication was ordered filed.

Mr. Tyte referred to the matter of the proposed leasing of property in Jamesport to the Riverhead Yacht Club and stated that as long as these matters are discussed and planned in executive sessions, the townspeople have no way of knowing about it until it is published.

Supervisor Vojvoda asked Mr. Tyte if this would eliminate lies being used and petitions from being circulated.

Mr. Tyte replied saying that if it was done in an open meeting, it might eliminate the idea of anyone circulating petitions to push it to a vote or force the Town to the expense of a referendum vote.

Mr. Tyte further stated that the people resent it being offered as a take-it-or-leave-it-as-is package deal, and that his argument is that the people are not cued in on what's going on until too late in the game and that he is not saying that it might not be sold on its merits to the general public if as it develops some good points are brought out.

Supervisor Vojvoda asked Mr. Tyte if he means that when an individual asks for a private hearing or session, the Town Board should not grant this courtesy.

Mr. Tyte replied saying that he realizes that the Board has to work out many details in private but the ready of the Conservative statement does not ask that pay raises and such other matters need be discussed in public.

A lengthy discussion ensued, entered into by Supervisor Vojvoda, Town Justice Zaloga, Wickham Tyte, Councilman Young, Town Attorney Shepard Scheinberg and Edward Purcell.

Mr. Harry Rambo of Riverhead voiced his objection to the proposed lease of property to the Riverhead Yacht Club.

Jacob Harding, Esq., addressed the Board and expressed Merry Christmas Greetings and wishes for a Happy and Prosperous New Year.
The Town Board expressed its appreciation to Mr. Harding for his good wishes.

Alex E. Horton, Supt. of Highways requested a map of the Suffolk Land Holding Corporation Subdivision.

Mr. Horton advised the Board that the existing drainage problems of J. Hartmann on Sound Avenue and Modern Tractor are of a serious nature and should be corrected at the earliest possible time.

The Board advised Mr. Horton to confer with Councilman Young and make report to the Board.

HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS

Donald Rhuda, Recreation Supervisor rendered the following report on the 2nd Annual National Recreation and Parks Congress held in Miami Beach, Florida on December 3rd through 7th:

"The Conference of over 10,000 administrators covered national trends in recreation facilities as well as professional problems of recruitment, personnel standards, wages, zoning and comprehensive planning.

Honored guests included Florida's Governor Kirk, Vice President Humphrey and Commissioner of Recreational and Cultural Activities August Heckscher of New York City.

Featured in the 5 day convention was an outdoor demonstration of park and playground equipment and a tour of regional recreation facilities.

An interesting note was struck by one keynote speaker who suggested that "Parks are visible proof that the Town Board cares."

Police Chief Stephen J. Grodski informed the Board that recently the U. S. Dept. of Justice has changed its policy and is now offering assistance to Police Departments. That he has received an application form for a sight-sound projector (Twin Beacon Rays with Visibar), price of which is \$820.00, however if the Town applies for assistance, it can be obtained for \$260.00. (A saving of \$560.00).

Police Chief Grodski explained the operation of this equipment, displayed a picture of same and requested authorization to make application for assistance. The Town Board gave oral permission to the Police Chief to make application.

The Town Board discussed "tires" with Mr. Edward Yousik.

Re Lease for Rental of Town Hall Quarters.

The matter of renewing Lease for rental of Town Hall Quarters was discussed by the Board.

The Town Attorney was directed to make request for a two year renewal.

The rental under the renewal lease will be \$6800 per annum together with 60% of any increase in taxes over \$2400.

Mr. Wickham Tyte addressed the Board and stated that Shepard Modecai Scheinberg has been a good Town Attorney. Mr. Tyte commended Mr. Scheinberg for being very fair and efficient and wished him well.

Town Justice Zaloga also commended Mr. Scheinberg for doing a good job as Town Attorney and stated that if he would be available the Board would be willing to retain him for another two years.

Town Justice Costello also commended Mr. Scheinberg for his competence and stated he was sorry to see him leave the employ of the Town.
