

The Board of Town Officers of the Town of Riverhead met at the Town Clerk's Office Friday, October 12' 1894 at 3 P.M.

All members being present.

Mr. Archibald Hallett of the Hallett Electric Co., appeared before the Board by Geo. F. Stackpole Attorney, and stated that they were unable to fulfill contract, without great loss, on account of insufficiency of water power, and asked that some new arrangement be made, inasmuch as Mr. Charles Hallett had died, and that unless some relief was given, they would be compelled to give up business.

Motion by J. Halsey Young and seconded by Daniel R. Young.

That the Hallett Electric Light Co., be allowed to discontinue lighting after 1 o'clock A.M. until 19 February 1895.

James L. Millard excused from voting.

Motion carried.

George W. Creighton was appointed Inspector of Elections in and for Dist. No. 2, vice Daniel A. Corwin moved out of district.

Sylvester M. Foster was appointed Inspector of Elections in and for Dist. No. 3, vice, himself, failed to qualify ac-

ording to law.

J. Edwin Hallock was appointed Inspector of Elections in
and for Dist. No. 4, by failure Board of Inspectors to ap-
point according to law.

Meeting adjourned.
