

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, December 9, 1936 at 9:00 A. M.

Roger M. Wiley, Town Attorney and William H. Clark, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on November 26, 1936 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from Harry G. Penny, Secretary of the Riverhead Fire Department inclosing report on the election held on December 1, 1936, showing Geroge W. Hildreth elected Commissioner for five years and Harry G. Penny elected Secretary for three years. The report was ordered placed on file.

The Supervisor's report for the month of November was submitted to the Board, and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The matter of the construction of a storm sewer on Pulaski Street at intersection of Claus Avenue to Raynor Avenue and thence to Peconic River together with an estimated cost of same was submitted to the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Boutcher it was RESOLVED that the Supt. of Highways be and he is hereby authorized and directed to construct a storm sewer on Pulaski Street at Claus Avenue to Raynor Avenue and thence to Peconic River, work to commence as soon as possible. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Kelly and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Supervisor Burns advised the Board that a resident of the Town of Riverhead has spoken to him relative to conditions said to exist in connection with the calling of ambulances and wrecking cars, following accidents in the Town, referred the matter to the Police Committee for investigation and report.

On motion made by Justice Kelly and seconded by Justice Luce, it was RESOLVED that Supervisor Burns be authorized to execute a right-of-way agreement between Burton L. Woodson and the Town of Riverhead, for a permanent easement across his property for the sum of \$250.00. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Kelly and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized and

and directed to pay the sum of \$1500.00 to the Riverside Engineering Corporation from the Current Surplus Account, said Current Surplus Account to be re-imbursed \$1500.00 after January 1, 1937 from the Item "Bulkheading" in the 1937 Budget - General Town Fund - Miscellaneous Account. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Kelly and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined Town bills to date.

On motion and vote the Town Board then adjourned to meet on Wednesday, December 30, 1936 at which time all Town records will be audited for the year, 1936.
