

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held in the Town Clerk's office Wednesday, Dec. 22, 1909 at 2 o'clock, p. m.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the Town Clerk be authorized to advertise for bids for lighting the Riverhead Lighting District with ninety lights, to be lighted from sunset to sundown.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Whereas, Peconic River in the County of Suffolk, New York, is becoming obstructed and the channel therein is rapidly filling up and becoming impassable, now therefore,

Resolved, That we, the undersigned, members of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, bordering on and bounded by said river do hereby petition the Legislature of the State of New York, to appropriate the sum of \$20,000 for the purpose of widening and deeping the channel in said river.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the Town Superintendent be instructed to prepare specifications for widening the highway at

Jamesport in accordance with the decision of the Commission and that such specifications be submitted to the County Supt. of Highways and upon said County Supt. approving same that the Town Supt. immediately advertise for bids for widening said road.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the Town Supt. be instructed to prepare specifications for laying out a new highway at Wading River in accordance with the decision of the Commission that such specifications be submitted to the County Supt. in accordance with the provisions of the Highway Law and upon said County Supt. approving the same that the Town Supt. immediately advertise for bids for laying out said highway.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
