

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, July 31, 1935 at 9:00 A.M.

Supt. of Highways Clark was present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on July 10, 1935 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works acknowledging receipt of five copies of the application of the Town of Riverhead, N. Y. for a Federal grant to be used for the construction of a sewer system. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from the State Education Department calling to the attention of the Board, Section 640 of the Education Law, which requires the Town Board to appoint on or before August 1st of each year one or more attendance officers for the Town and fix their compensation.

On motion made by Justice Stackpole and seconded by Justice Hallock, it was RESOLVED that Lorimer M. Raynor be and he hereby is appointed Attendance Officer of Riverhead School Districts Nos. 8, 9, 10 and 11, and be it further

RESOLVED that the compensation of the said Attendance Officer be fixed at the rate of \$250.00 per year, payable semi-annually, which compensation shall include all expenses other than those incurred when attending meetings outside of the Town of Riverhead, called by the District Superintendent of Schools, at which time actual expenses are to be paid by the Town of Riverhead. The vote, Justices Stackpole, Luce and Hallock, Yes, Justice Rubenstein, absent, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, No 0, Absent 1. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Hallock and seconded by Justice Luce it was RESOLVED that Roger McCabe be and he hereby is appointed Attendance Officer of Riverhead School Districts Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 12 and 13, and be it further

RESOLVED that the compensation of the said Attendance Officer be fixed at the rate of \$250.00 per year, payable semi-annually, which compensation shall include all expenses other than those incurred when attending meetings outside of the Town of Riverhead, called by the District Superintendent of Schools, at which time actual expenses are to be paid by the Town of Riverhead. The vote, Justices Stackpole, Luce and Hallock, Yes, Justices Rubenstein, absent, Supervisor Burns, No. Total vote, Yes 3, Absent 1, No 1. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Mr. Burton Woodson addressed the Board calling to their attention the dangerous intersection of Raynor Avenue and Pulaski Street and requested that traffic signals be placed at that intersection. The matter was referred to the Supt. of Highways.

On motion made by Justice Luce and seconded by Justice Hallock, it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized to transfer the sum of \$75.60 from the Surplus Account to a new account to be known as the Constable Account for the purpose of paying the salary of the Constable at the Wading River Beach. The vote, Justices Stackpole, Luce and Hallock, Yes, Justice Rubenstein, Absent, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Absent 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Hallock and seconded by Justice Luce it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized to transfer the sum of \$121.67 from the Surplus Account to the Municipal Indebtedness Account for the purpose of paying the interest on Certificates of Indebtedness for snow removal for 1935. The vote, Justices Stackpole, Luce and Hallock, Yes, Justice Rubenstein, absent, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Absent 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion duly made by Justice Hallock and seconded by Justice Luce it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized to transfer the sum of \$20.00 from the Surplus Account to the Tax Receivers Account to cover deficiency caused by receipt of a counterfeited bill by the Receiver of Taxes. The vote, Justices Stackpole, Luce and Hallock, Yes, Justice Rubenstein, absent, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Absent 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Stackpole and seconded by Justice Luce it was RESOLVED by unanimous consent that the Hospital bill of Roman Rogers be referred to Reginald C. Smith, Town Attorney and together with Welfare Officer investigate the matter and render an opinion.

Justices Hallock and Luce, the Committee on the matter of accepting Prospect Place as a Town Highway reported that they had investigated the matter and recommended the acceptance of the road if the proper alterations were made.

On motion duly made by Justice Stackpole and seconded by Supervisor Burns it was RESOLVED by unanimous consent that Prospect Place will be accepted as a Town Highway providing that the west boundary line is straightened.

Supt. of Highways Clark addressed the Board stating that several complaints have been made to him in regard to certain driveways causing cars to be damaged while going in and out. On motion and vote, the matter was referred to the Town Attorney for an opinion in the matter.
