

The Board of Town Officers of the Town of Riverhead met at the Town Hall Tuesday July 25' 1893 at 2' o'clock.

All of the members being present.

A Notice having been given that a meeting would be held at this time for the purpose of obtaining the sentiment of the people in regard to the lighting of the Streets in School Dist. No. 5, considerable discussion was had for and against the same, which finally resulted in a motion being carried by an informal vote of 16 for and 2 against, to establish a lighting district and to light the same at a cost not to exceed \$1000. per annum.

A motion to proceed to establish a lighting District within the limits of School District No. 5 in the Village of Riverhead was carried.

On motion of J. Halsey Young, the Town Clerk was voted a Committee to obtain information in relation to cost or expense per oil lamp or a specified number of oil lamps.

After which the Meeting adjourned.
