

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of
Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, August 14, 1935 at 9:00 A. M.

Reginald C. Smith, Town Attorney was present.

A communication was read from the Suffolk County Board of Supervisors stating that Monday, November 25, 1935 is the date fixed which time taxes for the next fiscal year for Suffolk County shall be levied.

A communication was read from Mr. John Doefler, Calverton, N. Y. asking the Board to look into the matter of the legality of the Town repairing a drive-way east of the Mary T. Reeve estate, claimed to be private. On motion and vote the matter was referred to a Committee composed of Justices Luce and Rubenstein together with Town Attorney Smith for investigation.

The matter of traffic turning off of the State Highway on a red light was discussed by the Board.

On motion made by Justice Hallock and seconded by Justice Stackpole it was RESOLVED that signs be placed on each traffic light on the State Highway indicating right turn on red light off the State Highway and be it further

RESOLVED that the Town Clerk write a letter to J. J. Darcy, State Engineer, Babylon, N. Y. for his approval of the above action. The vote, Justices Stackpole, Rubenstein, Luce and Hallock, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Hallock and seconded by Justice Stackpole, it was RESOLVED that this Board extend a vote of thanks to Mr. C. W. Anderson for his work in connection with figuring out a more feasible way of parking cars on the south-side of Main Street in front of the business section which will help relieve traffic congestion. The motion was unanimously carried.

On motion made by Justice Rubenstein and seconded by Justice Luce it was RESOLVED that Reginald C. Smith, Town Attorney be and he hereby is authorized and directed to renew the leases on the property used as the Town parking space. The vote, Justices Stackpole, Rubenstein, Luce and Hallock, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Luce and seconded by Justice Rubenstein it was RESOLVED that proper signs be placed which will direct traffic to the free parking space of the Town, the cost not to exceed the sum of \$50.00 and that a Committee be appointed to attend to the matter. The vote, Justices Stackpole, Rubenstein, Luce and Hallock, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Supervisor Burns appointed Justices Luce and Hallock on the above Committee.

Mr. John B. Schmitt, addressed the Board stating that it would be impossible for him to serve as Town Auditor after the 15th of August, 1935 owing to other duties.

Justice Stackpole offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Rubenstein

WHEREAS Mr. John B. Schmitt has expressed his desire to relinquish his duties as Town Auditor of the Town of Riverhead owing to other responsibilities, now therefore be it

RESOLVED that the Board take this opportunity to express their appreciation of the diligent and skillful manner in which Mr. Schmitt has performed his duties in setting up an accounting system which is of great benefit to the Town of Riverhead. The vote, Justices Stackpole, Rubenstein, Luce and Hallock, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Luce and seconded by Justice Hallock it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to submit an application to the W. P. A. as a project, for the construction of a Storm Sewer on Pulaski Street in the vicinity of Claus and Raynor Avenues. The vote, Justices Stackpole, Luce, Rubenstein and Hallock, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board recessed at 12:00 o'clock noon to reconvene at 1:15 P. M.


