Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town
of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Thursday
April 8th, 1915, at 2:00 O'clock P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion
adopted.

After carefully considering the needs of the various
roads throughout the Town, an agreement for the apportion-
ment of Highway Moneys for the year 1915 was entered into
between the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead and Town
Superintendent of Highways, William A. Brown and a copy of
such agreement duly filed in the Town Clerk's Office.

On motion Supervisor, D. T. Corwin was appointed a
committee to sell the Stone Crusher now owned by the town.

On motion the following resolution was adopted and
ordered published four times in the local papers.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

It shall be unlawful for any merchant or
storekeeper to permit rubbish, refuse or in-
flammable matter to be placed or collect at
the rear of his store or place of business. Any
person violating the provisions of this ordi-
nance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and in
addition thereto shall be liable to a penalty of
\$10 to be recovered in an action by the Super-
visor on behalf of the town.

It shall be unlawful for any person, either
as owner, lessee or manager, who shall conduct
any place of public entertainment, such as
halls or theatres, in the Town of Riverhead,
to permit or allow any chairs to be placed in
the aisles of such public places during any
public performance, or to allow persons to
stand more than one deep in the rear of the
seats, or to fail to display a red light at all
exits, or to permit or allow the stairways, halls,
entrances or exits to be occupied or obstructed
in any manner whatever during any public
performance. All entrances, stairways, hall-
ways and exits shall be adequately lighted.

Any person violating the provisions of this
ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor,
and in addition thereto shall be liable to a pen-
alty of \$10 to be recovered in an action by the
Supervisor on behalf of the town.

Upon motion, it was voted that the Chief of
the Riverhead Fire Department be authorized
to make an investigation of all public places
of amusement referred to in the foregoing ordi-
nance at any time and to immediately report
all violations thereof to the Supervisor.
